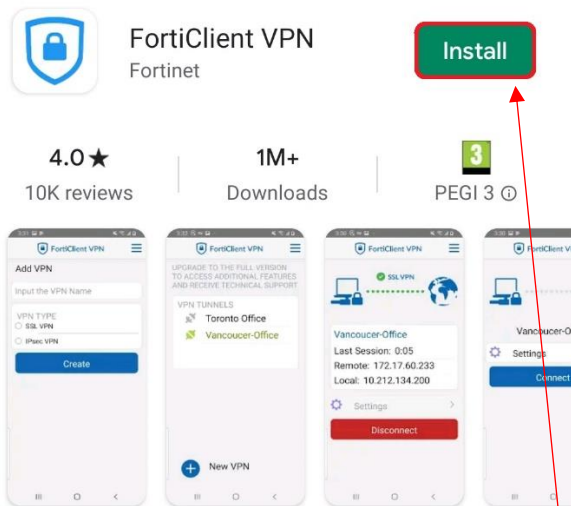
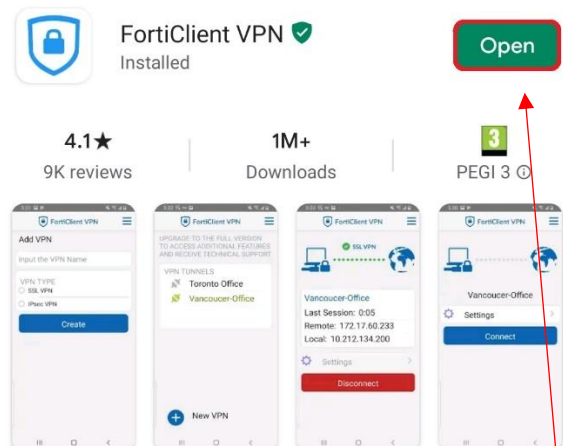


Set up VPN on Android
