Ross Priory is situated in an unrivalled position on the banks of Loch Lomond with stunning views of Ben Lomond and the surrounding hills, yet only 40 minutes from Glasgow.

Approached by a breathtaking tree lined driveway in its own private grounds, Ross Priory offers a secluded and unusual venue, enhanced by magnificent gardens and beautiful views to form a spectacular setting for any event.

One of the finest examples of gothic architecture in Scotland, this fascinating and historic building dates back to around 1693. The grounds extend to almost 200 acres including 9 hole golf course.

The house has meeting/reception rooms and dining space to cater for up to 60 delegates with some bed and breakfast accommodation available for residential guests.

The Carnegie Room

The largest and most versatile of our meeting facilities, the Carnegie Room provides elegance with its period features. With views of Loch Lomond and our 9 hole golf course, the double aspect floods the room with natural light. Located on the main reception level, this room can seat:

Theatre style: up to 60

Boardroom style: up to 26

Horseshoe style: up to 24

Cabaret style (square tables): up to 36



The McGougan Room

Rich in original features, the McGougan Room is situated on the main reception level, situated to the rear of the house, overlooking the gardens. This room is ideal for boardroom meetings and presentations. It can seat:

Theatre style: up to 30

Boardroom style: up to 22

Horseshoe style: up to 20

Classroom style (tables for 2): up to 12



The Scott Room

Named after Sir Walter Scott, who is recorded as a frequent visitor to Ross Priory in the early 19th century while gathering much of his material for *Lady of the Lake* and *Rob Roy*, the Scott Room is located on the upper floor of the house. It overlooks both the loch and golf course. A quiet space, it offers an ideal spot for a writing retreat or for boardroom discussions. The room can seat:

Theatre style: up to 18

Boardroom style: up to 12

Horseshoe style: up to 10

Bedroom Accommodation

The house has a total of 11 stylish en suite bedrooms with lovely views of the loch, golf course or gardens, all available for bed & breakfast.

- 2 executive double en suite bedrooms (king size bed)
- 3 en suite double bedrooms (double bed)
- 2 en suite family bedrooms (each with 1 double bed and 1 single)
- 4 en suite twin bedrooms (each with 2 single beds)

There is also a self-catering cottage on the loch shores within close proximity to the main house. This has 2 bedrooms, a comfortable lounge, kitchen and family bathroom.

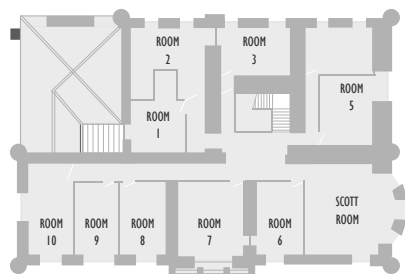

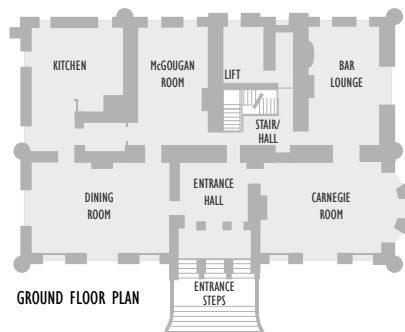


Floorplans

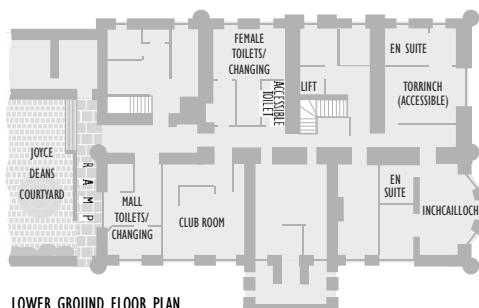
Lift access is available between the main reception level and the lower ground floor. The first floor is only accessible by staircase.

Outdoor Events and Pursuits

With a 9 hole golf course and extensive grounds, Ross Priory can host events such as tournaments and team building activities. It has also been the location for a number of charity days as well as filming location for commercials and television productions. The pontoon allows seasonal access to the loch.

The estate comprises 200 acres of beautiful grounds, containing a remarkable collection of rhododendrons and azaleas and a marvellous walled garden.
