



Strathclyde Research Portal Launch

The Research Portal is a new on-line 'space' which holds information relating to Research and Knowledge Exchange allowing it to be more easily shared across the University, and contains various information resources, including a new University-wide Events Calendar. There is also functionality to enable collaborative working on-line (e.g. document libraries, co-authoring of documents and threaded discussion forums).

The Portal is organised into four domains:

1. **Research in Practice** – ethics, practical advice on making applications to research councils, charities and other funders plus internal funding;
2. **Knowledge Exchange in Practice** – working with companies and building relationships, commercialisation of research, KE mechanisms such as KTP, CPD;
3. **Developing a Research Career at Strathclyde** – research induction process, advice for early career researchers and support available from the Postgraduate Research Office including Studentships information and Roberts Funding;
4. **People & Collaboration** – existing research collaborations and pooling arrangements involving Strathclyde researchers plus the opportunity to set up an on-line 'space' for management and facilitation of internal collaborations.

Some of the key benefits of utilising this resource:

- Access to a University-wide Calendar of Events with the opportunity to publicise your own events
- Opportunity to create an on-line 'space' for collaborative working, document sharing and co-authoring etc.
- Information about Internal funding opportunities
- Increased knowledge about external research funding (opportunities, the application process, etc.)
- Increased knowledge of the range of knowledge exchange mechanisms and advice on how to build relationships with external organisations
- Advice for career development (currently mainly limited to Early Career Researchers and new staff induction)
