









The **Technology and Innovation Centre** is a world-class research hub, which is revolutionising collaboration between academia, industry and the public sector.

Our flagship facility was named Best Academic Venue at the M & IT Awards 2018, and is home to dedicated conferencing facilities for up to 600 delegates, available all year round.



## Auditoria

Our **Main Auditorium** accommodates up to 450 delegates in air-conditioned comfort. A system of movable walls allows us to subdivide the room into a flat-floored space for 150 and tiered auditoria seating 150 or 300.

A further 150-seater auditorium on Level 1 is perfect for day conferences and large breakout groups.





# Foyers

Spacious, interconnected **foyers** link our conferencing spaces; with natural daylight and contemporary furnishing, they are the perfect venue for networking, catering and exhibitions.

## Conference Rooms


The Centre's **Conference Rooms** offer bright, comfortable accommodation for up to 40 delegates. With flexible layouts and user-friendly audio-visual solutions, they are perfect for meetings, smaller conferences and breakout sessions. Movable walls allow us to open some rooms to accommodate 60-80 delegates.

At the top of the building, the **Executive Suite** offers a flexible, self-contained venue for up to 100 delegates, with its own registration area and networking foyer, as well as views right across the campus.

# The Barony

The Victorian grandeur of **The Barony** is a spectacular contrast to the clean lines of the Technology and Innovation Centre. Dating from 1889, this former church is a splendid neo-gothic confection in red sandstone.

Home to our graduation ceremonies, the Great Hall is a stunning backdrop for hospitality – seated dinners for up to 220 and standing receptions of 600 – and conferences, seating up to 600 in theatrestyle. With a number of adjacent ancillary rooms, The Barony offers flexible options for a variety of events.

#### By bus

Buchanan Bus Station is o.6 miles away and runs frequent services to Glasgow International Airport and all parts of the country.

The Glasgow Shuttle (FirstBus 500) connects Glasgow International Airport to the city centre 24 hours a day, 364 days a year. The service runs up to every 10 minutes with a stop conveniently located outside Queen St station, just a few minutes' walk from the Strathclyde campus.

#### **Fitness fanatics**

Of course, a city-centre campus means we're easily accessible by foot, if you like to avoid the traffic rush. Bike stands are also available outside the main entrance of the Technology and Innovation Centre, for all cycling enthusiasts.

You can rent a bike via the NextBike App or through the on-bike computer. Rental starts at £1 for the first 30 minutes.



























### Main Auditorium - A, B and C

Accommodating up to 450 delegates, the Main Auditorium is our principal conferencing venue. An innovative system of movable walls and electronic partitions divides the Auditorium into a tiered section for 300 and a flat-floored section for 150, or three sections each accommodating 150 delegates.

Each section of the Auditorium is acoustically discreet and fully self-contained when subdivided, with separate access to/from the adjacent foyers on Levels 2 and 3.

The tiered sections have sockets under every seat, ensuring that delegates can stay connected throughout your conference. With state-of-the-art audiovisual equipment – including LED lighting which allows you to theme the room in corporate colours and spotlight speakers – the Main Auditorium is an impressive and flexible contemporary backdrop for your event.

## Level 2 Foyer

Level 2 Foyer is located immediately adjacent to the Main Auditorium and the Main Entrance. With plenty of natural daylight and comfortable, contemporary furnishings, the Foyer is ideal for registration, catering and exhibitions.

With a flat floor, ample 13-amp power supply and ready access to/from the building's Goods Entrance, Level 2 Foyer is the ideal location for exhibitions – posters, table-top or shell scheme.

A glazed staircase offers direct access to Levels 1 and 3, allowing larger events to spread comfortably across multiple floors.

For evening events, the Level 2 Foyer is perfect for informal receptions of up to 300 or seated dinners for up to 220.


## Level 3 Conference Rooms and Foyers

Clustered around a bright central foyer, our Conference Rooms are ideal for smaller conferences, meetings and breakout sessions. There are eight rooms, all of which enjoy natural daylight and user-friendly audio-visual solutions.

Flat floors and movable furniture make for maximum flexibility in terms of layout, while removing soundproof partitions between Rooms 4 and 5 and Rooms 6 and 7 allows us to accommodate larger groups.

Level 3 Foyer offers a comfortable, flexible circulation space connecting the Conference Rooms and the Main Auditorium.

The centre section works well in combination with the Level 2 Foyer – directly accessible via a central, glazed staircase – to accommodate larger exhibitions, while the airy Mezzanine area is ideal for informal networking and poster displays.












## Level 1 Auditorium and Foyer

With its comfortable, gently-raked seating and user-friendly audio-visual equipment, Level 1 Auditorium is ideal for smaller conferences and lectures, or larger breakout sessions.

The adjacent foyer is suitable for registration and refreshment breaks for up to 70 delegates. The Level 1 Auditorium can also be used in combination with the larger foyer spaces on Levels 2 and 3, which are accessible by stairs and lift.



Images: Delegates in the Auditorium; Auditorium from rear





### Level 9 Executive Suite

The Executive Suite's two meeting rooms are equipped to the same specification as the Conference Rooms on Level 3, while a movable soundproof partition allows us to open the space for groups of up to 100. Adjustable blackout blinds let you flood the Suite with natural light during networking breaks.

With its own bright, spacious foyer, registration desk and cloakroom, the Executive Suite is completely self-contained – perfect for high-profile meetings, away days, smaller conferences and private dining.


