


Connecting to eduroam on a Windows laptop

You will first need to configure your laptop in order to connect to eduroam. To do this you will need to download and install a configuration tool. This can be done by connecting to the StrathWifiSetup network available in the Library and Student Residences. The following instructions show the steps for doing so on a Windows laptop. Different versions of Windows may vary slightly in layout but the process will remain the same. You will only need to configure your device once and thereafter it will automatically connect to eduroam.

1. Click on the Wifi icon.
2. In the pop-up box that appears, click on StrathWifiSetup.

3. In the drop-down box, click on Connect.

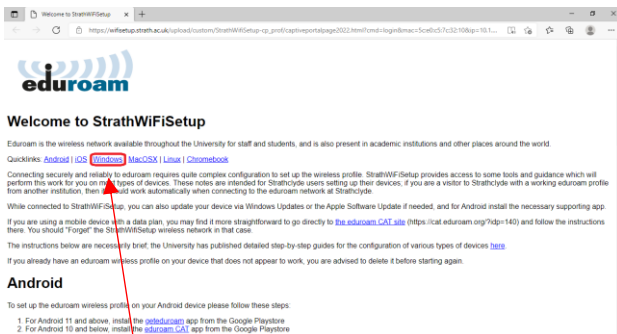

If it doesn't, open a browser and enter wifisetup.strath.ac.uk into the address bar.

Click on Windows.

Microsoft Windows

- To set up the eduroam wireless profile on your Microsoft Windows device please follow these steps:
1. Run the [eduroam wireless profile installer from eduroam.org](#)
 2. Once the eduroam wireless profile is installed, tell your device to "Forget" the StrathWiFiSetup network so you do not continue to connect to it.

Note that you can also use the [peduroam.ac.uk](#) to set up eduroam on Windows devices, however this has not been tested.

Apple MacOSX

To set up the eduroam wireless profile on your Apple Mac device please follow these steps using the Safari browser (other browsers are not likely to work):

1. Run the [eduroam wireless profile installer from eduroam.org](#)
2. Once the eduroam wireless profile is installed, tell your device to "Forget" the StrathWiFiSetup network so you do not continue to connect to it.

Linux

To set up the eduroam wireless profile on your Linux device please follow these steps:

1. Run the [eduroam wireless profile installer from eduroam.org](#)
2. Once the eduroam wireless profile is installed, tell your device to "Forget" the StrathWiFiSetup network so you do not continue to connect to it.

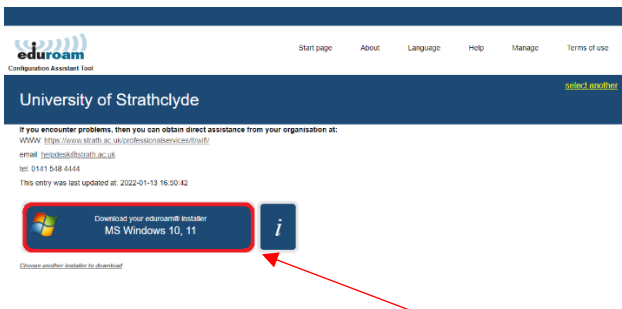
Google Chromebook (ChromeOS)

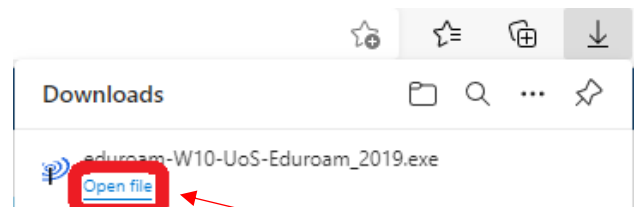
Important! – User name

When connecting to eduroam your username should be specified as your DS username, followed by @strath.ac.uk, for example: bsd1300@strath.ac.uk. The password is the same as for

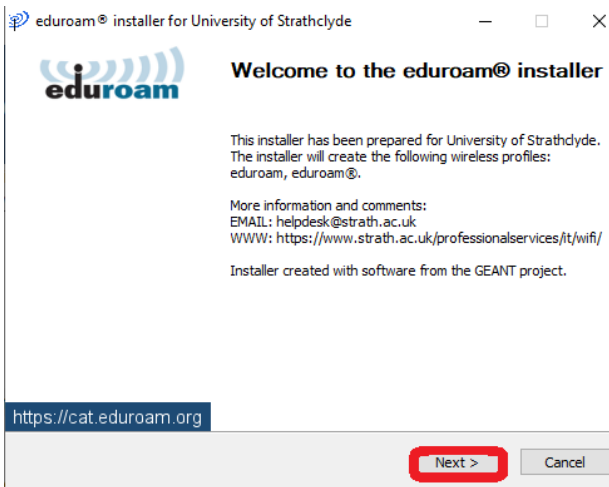
5. Click on eduroam wireless profile installer from eduroam.org



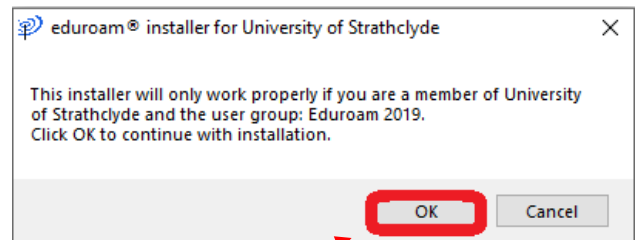
6. Click on Download your eduroam installer MS Windows 10, 11.



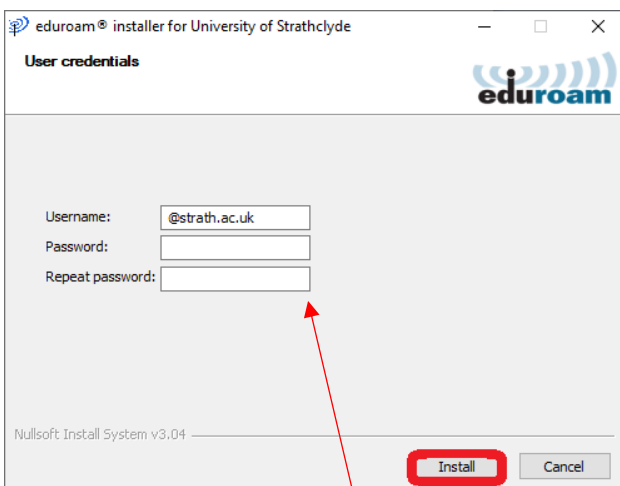
7. Once the download is complete, in the Downloads drop-down menu, click on Open file.



8. On the eduroam installer, click on Next.



9. Click on OK.

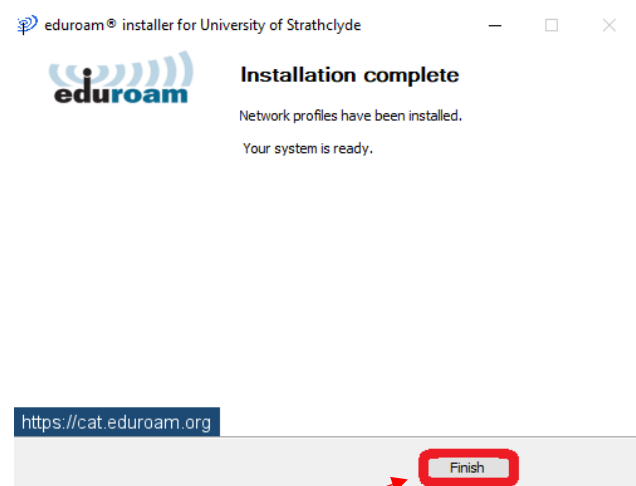


10. Where it says Username, enter your DS username before the @strath.ac.uk.

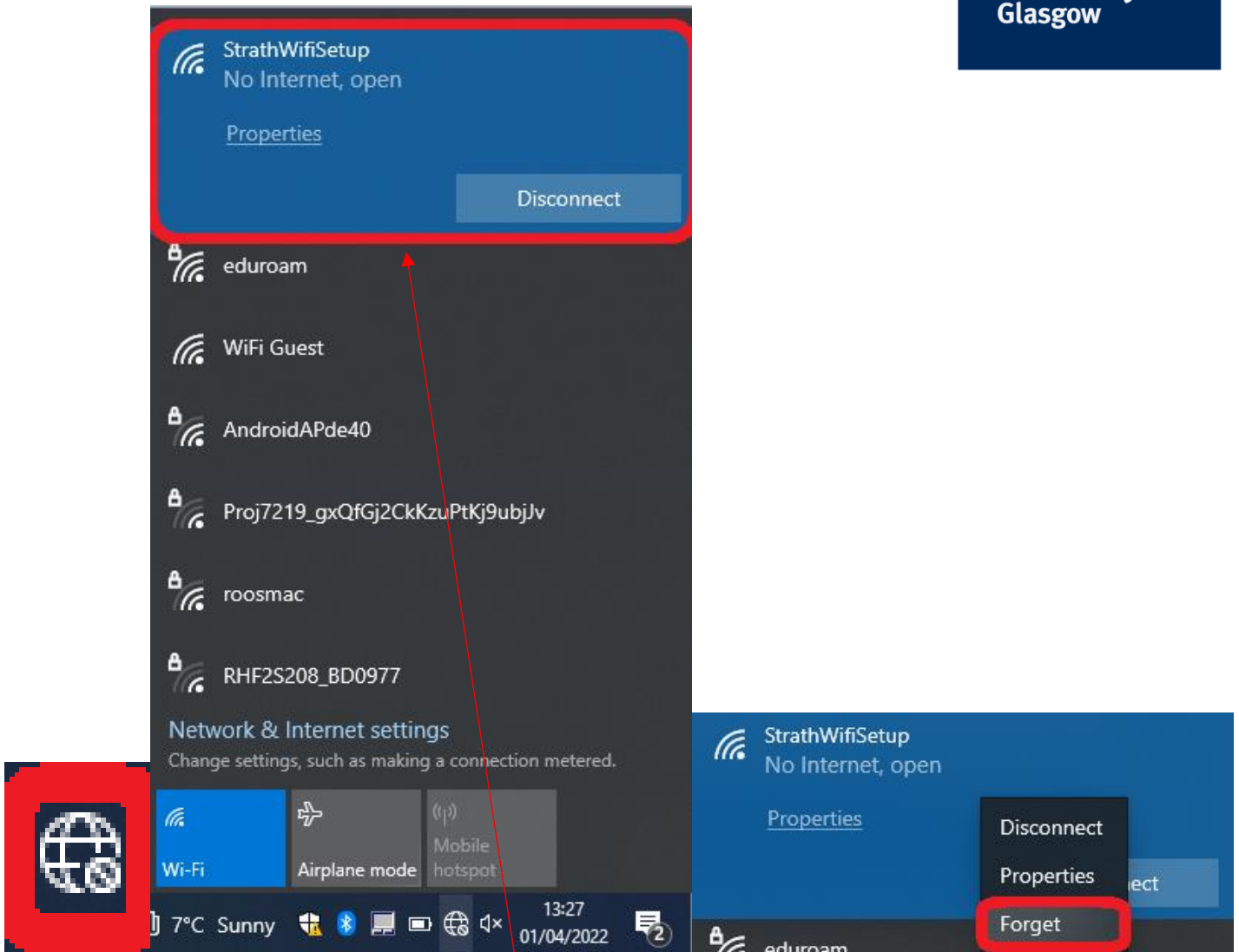
Where it says Password, enter your password.

Where it says Repeat password, enter your password.

Click on Install.



11. Click on Finish.



12. Click on the Wifi icon.

13. In the pop-up menu, right-click on StrathWifiSetup.

14. In the drop-down menu, click on Forget.

You will now automatically connect to eduroam.
