Declaration of Arbroath Family History Project

Progress report 4, 27 June 2019

Documentary strand

As reported in the previous Progress report, at least one set of research findings on all 48 individuals associated with the Declaration have now been submitted by Diploma students – 40 as part of this Project, in addition to findings on another 8 who had previously been researched as part of the Battle of Bannockburn Family History Project. These findings will be supplemented by submissions from Diploma students in the next academic session. The findings consist of brief biographies, four generation genealogies showing descendants of the grandparents of the focus individual and details of coats of arms. Genetic genealogy strand

The first phase of this strand involves the gathering of DNA test results from well documented male line descendants of some of those who were associated with the Declaration. Following on from this, the second phase will focus on analysis of test results and identifying matches with individuals who do not have documentary evidence of their medieval descents.

Preparatory work is currently being undertaken on 12 families.

The current status of the work is as follows -

- Sent out invitations to documented male line descendants to take a DNA test 5, with 2
 positive responses so far
- Issued invitations to documented male line descendants who have already taken a DNA test to join the Project 3, all have agreed to take part. There are also a number of other DNA test results available within the Project to allow further analysis
- Research needed to identify documented male line descendants (in progress) 4
