Mandatory and Elective classes

Mandatory classes: Mandatory classes include - Law and Practice of Construction Management; Dispute Resolution; Law of the Construction Industry. In addition, non-lawyers will take Legal Process & the Law of Contract while students with a legal background will take Context of Construction.

When students take each of the mandatory electives will be determined by the specific programme which they are enrolled.

Elective class: All students will take a total of two electives courses during the full length of their programme.

Full-time students will choose two electives in semester 2 of the one-year programme; part-time students will choose one elective either in semester 1 or 2 of the second year of the programme.
