Compulsory Classes

You need to take a total of 6 taught classes, including compulsory classes. You will also need to undertake a Summer Project over the summer months. More information on the options available will be provided in due course.

In terms of taught classes, there are two compulsory classes on this LLM. The first is M8909, Law of International Business, which is taught in the January semester. The second is M7928, The Law of the World Trade Organisation, which is taught in the September semester.

To specialise in Financial Regulation, there are two additional classes you must take alongside your compulsory modules: M9884, Financial Crime and Sanctions and M8912, Financial Regulation and Compliance.

To specialise in Antitrust Law, there are two additional classes must take alongside your compulsory modules: M7933 Antitrust Law and M7934 Antitrust Law and the Digital Economy.
