Voting took place from Wednesday 16 October, 12pm, to Wednesday 23 October, 12pm.

Overview Report

In accordance with Section 3 of the Higher Education Governance (Scotland) Act 2016, an overview of the applicants to the role is listed below. Detailed equality monitoring information was requested only of those candidates who submitted applications.

Where the number is <5 the release of personal data is exempt from disclosure as it risks the potential identification of individuals involved in the process. This information is therefore considered exempt under Section 38(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002: Personal information.

The University engaged in an open and robust recruitment process in line with the Higher Education Governance (Scotland) Act 2016. The opportunity was openly advertised and an executive search agency engaged to assist in the search process to encourage applications from a diverse pool of candidates. The following data has been provided by the executive search agency:

- Number of people approached by the search agency to discuss the role: 88
 - o Gender split: 67% female and 33% male
- Number of people who approached the search agency directly to discuss the role: 13
 - o Gender split: 39% female and 61% male
- Number of applicants for the role: 4
- Number of applicants who reached the interview stage: 3
- Number of applicants who met the criteria and were therefore eligible to stand for election: 2
