Come along to our Meet the Students point on level 4 of the Learning and Teaching building (23) and find out from our current students what it's really like to study here.

A great way to see the campus is to go on a campus tour, led by our student ambassadors. Tours take approximately 40 minutes and leave from the Meet the Students point starting from 10am; the last tour departs at 1.45pm.




