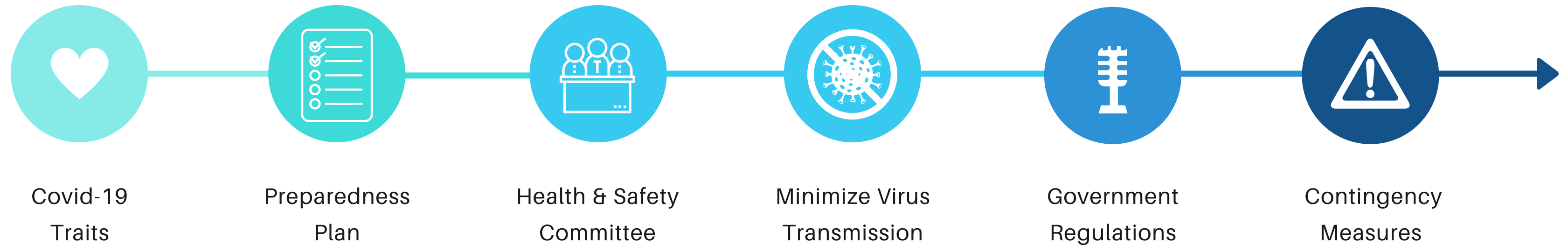

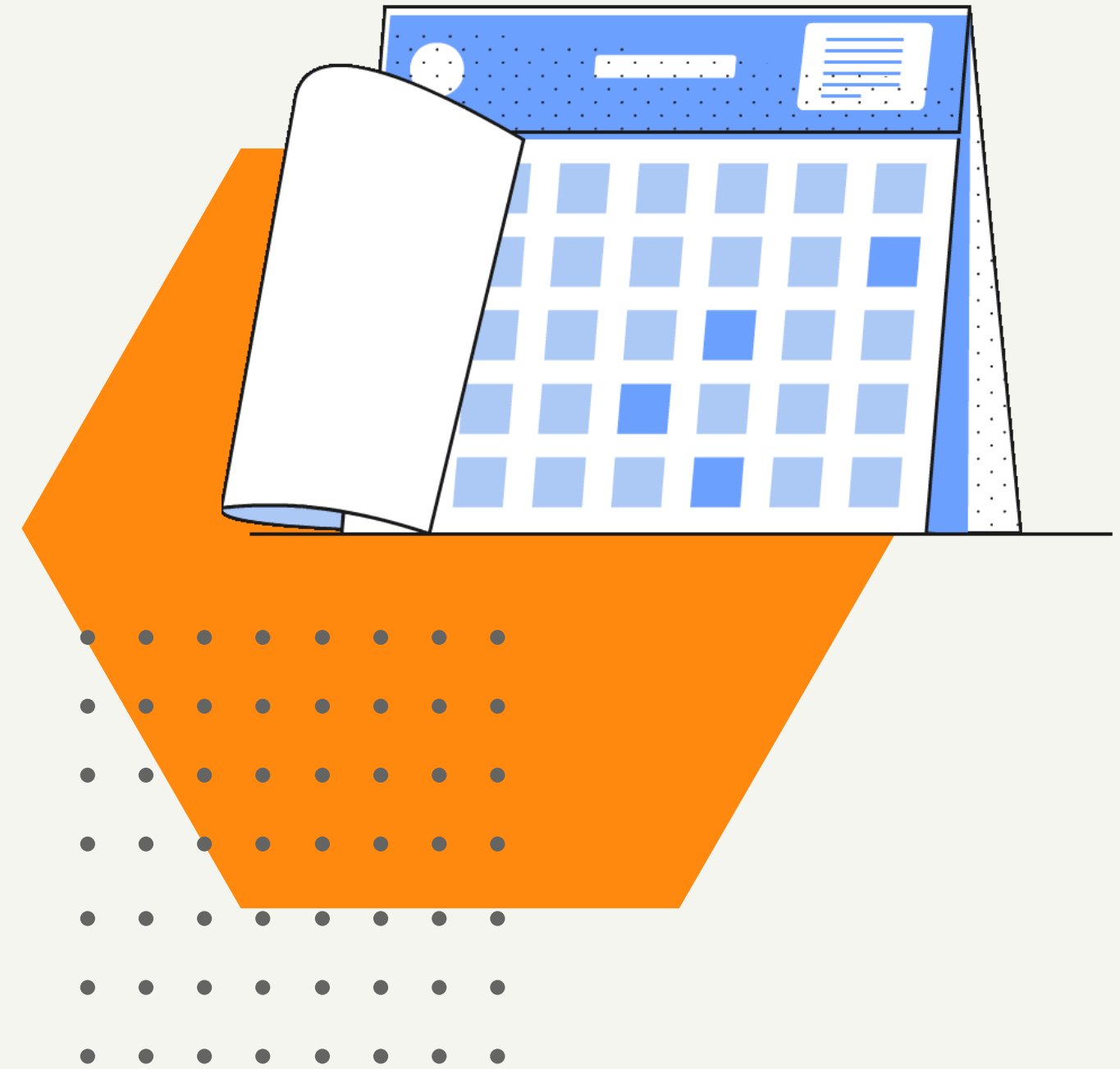


Covid-19 Traits

- New strain of coronavirus that causes respiratory illness
- Variety of symptoms similar to flu and pneumonia
- Highly contagious, unpredictable and spreads easily/silently
- Incubation period 2 to 14 days
- Increased risk of long term health effects and/or fatality rate

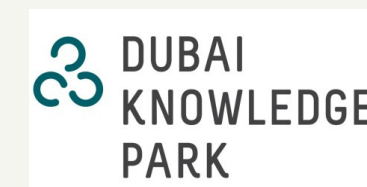
Preparedness Plan Summary

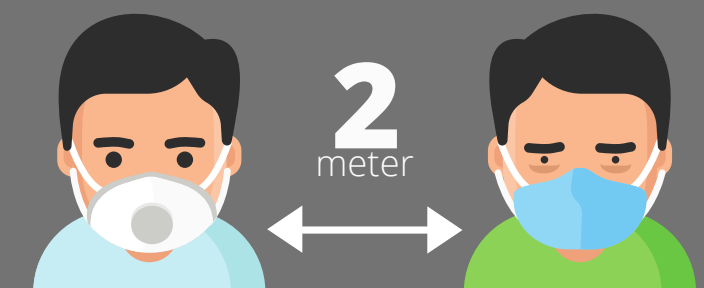
Protocols For Staying Safe



- Screening:
 - Thermal scanner
 - Pay attention to possible symptoms

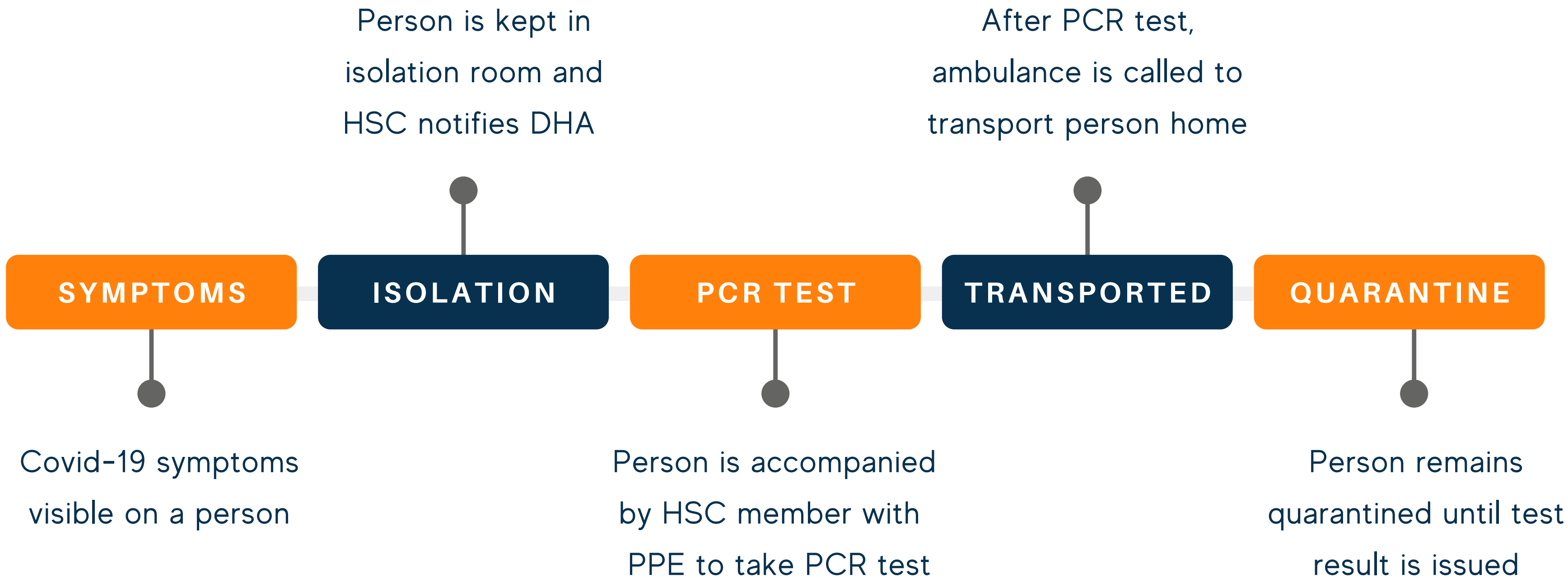
- Social distancing:
 - 2 metres at all times
 - Wear mask properly
 - No sharing of any items

- Hygiene:
 - Use sanitizer
 - Disinfection kit and UV box
 - Get into habit of sanitizing or washing hands
 - Wash hands frequently for 20+ seconds with soap



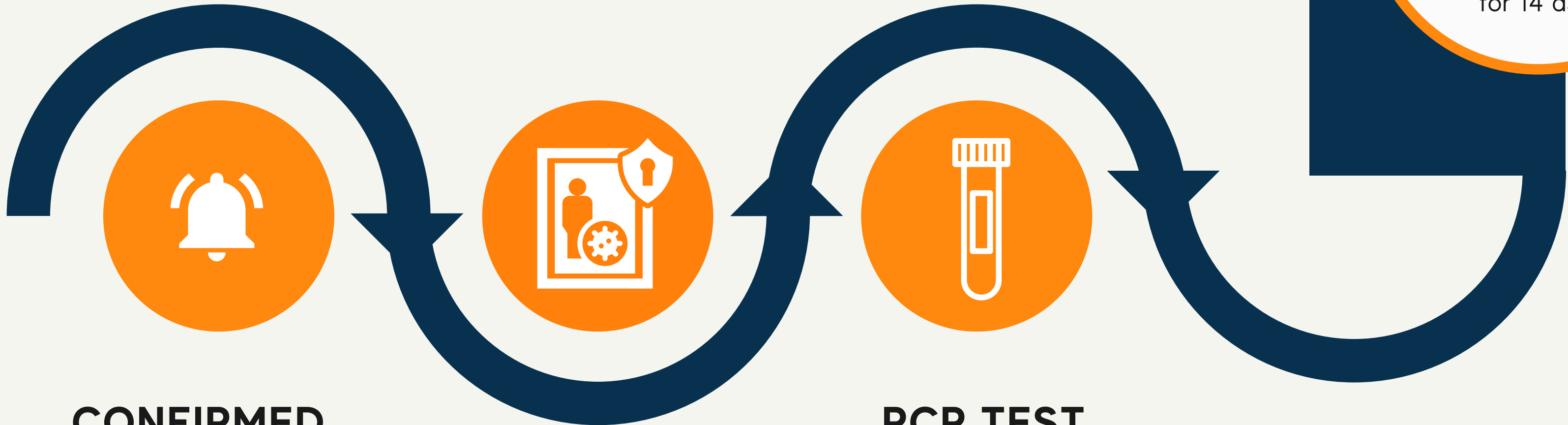
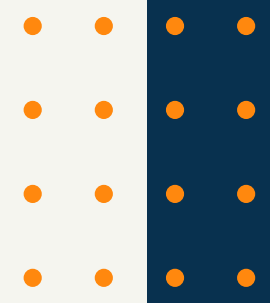


Contingencies For Suspected Cases





Contingencies For Confirmed Cases



QURANTINE

Person will quarantine for 14 days & notify others within close contact

CONFIRMED

PCR test confirms person with symptoms is infected with Covid-19

PCR TEST

Everyone gets tested and campus sealed off until results issued

SBS STAFF
In case a staff is tested positive for Covid-19, HSC will assign a substitute for 14 days

All students and staff on campus will be tested immediately

MORE NEW CASES

NO NEW CASES

Classes are transferred online for 14 days and everyone is requested to quarantine

A DM-approved company will disinfect the whole campus

HSC will follow up with all quarantined people at the end of 14-day period

On-campus classes resume after staff show no more symptoms

Campus is completely disinfected as per government standards

Classes resume as normal

Quarantined person reports conditions to hsc after 14 days for approval to re-enter campus
