1. This programme is offered jointly by the University of Strathclyde, the University of Glasgow, Heriot-Watt University, University of Edinburgh, University of Dundee and University of St Andrews. The awards are made in the name of one of these six Universities. The Regulations are drawn up consequent upon a Memorandum of Agreement for joint delivery of the degree which has been approved by Senate.
2. The taught component of the programmes may be delivered at university campuses or at independent work sites, but all modules are taught by staff from the six universities. Students shall be subject to the Programme Regulations that have been adopted by all six Universities and to any other General Regulations, etc., of the University at which they are registered.
3. For the current academic year, the administering university is Heriot-Watt University and full details of Programme Regulations applicable are shown in that University's Calendar.
