## **Doctor of Engineering in Offshore Renewable Energy**

- 1. This programme is offered jointly by the Universities of Edinburgh, Strathclyde and Exeter and Swansea as part of the EPSRC Centre for Doctoral Training in Offshore Renewable Energy (IDCORE) leading to the joint award of an Engineering Doctorate in Offshore Renewable Energy.
- The Regulations are drawn up consequent upon a Memorandum of Agreement for joint delivery of the degree, which has been approved by Senate. Students shall be subject to the Programme Regulations that have been adopted by all four Universities. These agreed regulations are published by the University of Edinburgh. - 3. The programme involves a compulsory taught element. The taught component is delivered by all four universities and administered wholly by the University of Edinburgh under the following Taught Assessment Regulations.
