Admission

- 1. Notwithstanding the <u>General Academic Regulations Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level</u>, applicants shall possess:
 - i. a first or upper second class Honours degree in Psychology or related discipline; or
 - ii. a qualification deemed by the Programme Leader and Head of Department acting on behalf of Senate to be equivalent to (i) above.
- 2. In all cases, applicants whose first language is not English, shall be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of English.

Duration of Study

Mode of Study

4. The programme is available by full-time or part-time study only.

Curriculum

- 5. Students studying on a part-time basis will normally take no fewer than 40 credits in each year.
- 6. All students studying shall undertake an approved curriculum;

Award

- 9. **Degree of MSc**: In order to qualify for the award of the degree of MSc in Adolescent Mental Health and Resilience a candidate must have performed to the satisfaction of the Board of Examiners and must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits of which 60 credits must have been awarded in respect of the dissertation Bxxxx.
- 10. **Postgraduate Diploma:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Adolescent Mental Health and Resilience, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the taught modules of the programme curriculum.
- 11. **Postgraduate Certificate**: In order to qualify for the award of Postgraduate Certificate in Adolescent Mental Health and Resilience, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the taught modules of the programme curriculum.
