## **Award**

8. **Degree of LLM in Global Environmental Law and Governance:** In order to qualify for the award of LLM in Global Environmental Law and Governance, a candidate must normally have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits including all taught compulsory modules from the programme curriculum including one of the 60 credit modules listed above.
9. **Degree of LLM in Global Environmental Law and Governance with a Specialisation in Ocean Law:** In order to qualify for the award of LLM in Global Environmental Law and Governance with a Specialisation in Ocean Law, a candidate must normally have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits including all taught compulsory modules from the programme curriculum including one of the 60 credit modules listed above.
10. **Postgraduate Diploma in Global Environmental Law and Governance:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Global Environmental Law and Governance, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the taught modules from the programme curriculum including all taught compulsory modules.
11. **Postgraduate Diploma in Global Environmental Law and Governance with a Specialisation in Ocean Law:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Global Environmental Law and Governance with a Specialisation in Ocean Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the taught modules from the programme curriculum including all taught compulsory modules.
