Master of Science in Health and Care Leadership Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Care Leadership Postgraduate Certificate in Health and Care Leadership

These regulations are to be read in conjunction with General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level.

#### Admission

- 1. See the General Academic Regulations Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level
- 2. In all cases, applicants whose first language is not English, shall be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of English.

# **Duration of study**

3. Notwithstanding the General Academic Regulations - Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level the maximum period of study shall be as follows:

i.	Masters by part-time study	60 months
ii.	PG Diploma by part-time study	48 months

- PG Diploma by part-time study ii. 24 months
- iii. PG Certificate by part-time study

#### Mode of study

4. The programme is available by blended learning only. This mode of study concerns a combination of online learning and face to face workshops.

#### Place of study

5. In accordance with the General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level, some off-campus work may be required.

#### Curriculum

- 6. All students shall undertake an approved curriculum as follows:
  - i. for the degree of MSc no fewer than 180 credits including a 40 credit research project.
  - ii. for the Postgraduate Diploma no fewer than 120 credits,
  - iii. for the Postgraduate Certificate no fewer than 60 credits.

# Award

- 9. **Degree of MSc**: In order to qualify for the degree of MSc in Health and Care Leadership, a candidate must have performed to the satisfaction of the Board of Examiners and must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, of which 40 credits must have been awarded in respect of the Service / Business Transformation Project.
- 10. **Postgraduate Diploma:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Care Leadership, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the programme curriculum.
- 11. **Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certificate in Health and Care Leadership, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the programme curriculum.
