- 15. In order to progress to the fourth year of the programme students must have passed BF307 Leadership Development Programme 2.

Final Assessment and Honours Classification

16. The final Honours classification for the degree of Bachelor of Business Administration with Honours will normally be based on the first assessed attempt at Level 4 modules taken in the fourth year.

- 18. **Bachelor of Arts:** In order to qualify for the award of the Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration – Bahrain, the <u>General Academic Regulations – Undergraduate, Integrated</u> <u>Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level</u> shall apply.
- 19. **Diploma of Higher Education:** In order to qualify for the award of a Diploma of Higher Education in Business Administration Bahrain, the <u>General Academic Regulations –</u> <u>Undergraduate, Integrated Master and Professional Graduate Degree Programme Level</u> shall apply.
