#### **Progress of Part-time students**

10. Part-time students for the degree of LLM or Postgraduate Diploma shall normally require 40 credits to progress to year two.

#### Award

- 11. **Degree of LLM**: In order to qualify for the award of LLM in Construction Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, including all taught compulsory modules from the programme curriculum of which 60 credits must have been awarded in respect of one of the 60 credit modules listed above.
- 12. **Postgraduate Diploma**: In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Construction Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 taught credits, including all taught compulsory modules from the programme curriculum.
- 13. **Postgraduate Certificate**: In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certification in Construction Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 taught credits including all taught compulsory modules from the programme curriculum.
