Progress

- Part-time students for the degree of LLM or Postgraduate Diploma shall normally require 40 credits to progress to year two.

Award

- Degree of LLM:** In order to qualify for the award of LLM, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, which must include one of the 60-credit modules.
- Degree of LLM in Law with specialisation in:** In order to qualify for the LLM in Law with named specialisation, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, which must include 60 credits of taught modules from the specialisation curriculum and one of the 60-credit modules with a topic within the field of the specialisation.
- Postgraduate Diploma:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the modules of the programme curriculum.
- Postgraduate Diploma in Law with specialisation in:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Law with named specialisation, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits including 60 credits of taught modules from the specialisation curriculum.
- Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certificate in Law, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the taught modules of the programme.
- Postgraduate Certificate in Law with specialisation in:** In order to qualify for the award of Postgraduate Certificate in Law with named specialisation, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits of taught modules, including 40 credits of taught modules from the specialisation curriculum.
