These regulations are to be read in conjunction with [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#).

Admission

1. Notwithstanding the [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#) applicants shall possess:
 - i. a first or second class Honours degree) from a United Kingdom university (in English or a closely related subject); or
 - ii. a qualification deemed by the Programme Director acting on behalf of Senate to be equivalent to (i) above, or
 - iii. have demonstrated competence in literary and cultural studies obtained at a level of performance acceptable to the Programme Director.
2. In all cases, applicants whose first language is not English, shall be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of English.

Duration of study

3. The [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#) shall apply.

Mode of study

4. The programme is available by full-time and part-time study.

Place of study

5. The programme will take place on-campus. In accordance with the [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#), some off-campus work may be required.

Curriculum

6. All students shall undertake an approved curriculum as follows:
 - i. for the degree of MSc no fewer than 180 credits including a 60 credit research project,
 - ii. for the Postgraduate Diploma no fewer than 120 credits,
 - iii. for the Postgraduate Certificate no fewer than 60 credits.

Award

- Degree of MSc:** In order to qualify for the degree of MSc in Literature, Culture and Society, a candidate must have performed to the satisfaction of the Board of Examiners and must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, of which 60 credits must have been awarded in respect of the Final Research Project QQ910.
- Postgraduate Diploma:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Literature, Culture and Society, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the programme curriculum.
- Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certificate in Literature, Culture and Society, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the programme curriculum.
