PRACTICE EDUCATION

Postgraduate Certificate in Practice Education and Leadership (Social Services)

These regulations are to be read in conjunction with [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#).

Admission

1. Notwithstanding the [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#) applicants shall possess:
 - i. An Honours, Postgraduate Diploma or Masters degree from a United Kingdom university in Social Work; or
 - ii. a qualification deemed by the Programme Director acting on behalf of Senate to be equivalent to (i) above.
2. In addition, all successful applicants must be registered as a Social Worker with the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC).
3. In all cases, applicants whose first language is not English, shall be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of English.

Duration of study

4. The [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#) shall apply.

Mode of study

5. The programme is available by part-time study only.

Place of study

6. In accordance with the [General Academic Regulations – Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#), some off-campus work may be required.

Curriculum

7. All students shall undertake an approved curriculum as follows:

9. The final award will be based on the student's performance in their assessments.

Award

10. **Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of Postgraduate Certificate in Practice Education and Leadership (Social Services), a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the programme curriculum.
