Admission

1. Notwithstanding the [General Academic Regulations - Postgraduate Taught Degree Programme Level](#), applicants shall possess:
 - i. a first or second class Honours degree of a United Kingdom University, in a relevant area (Finance, Accounting, Economics, Mathematics, Statistics or Computing); or
 - ii. a qualification deemed by the Programme Director acting on behalf of Senate to be equivalent to i. above.
2. In all cases, applicants whose first language is not English, shall be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of English.

Duration of Study

Mode of Study

4. The programmes are available by full-time and part time study.

Place of Study

5. Study will be undertaken at the University of Strathclyde, Bahrain.

Curriculum

6. All students shall undertake an approved curriculum as follows:
 - i. for the Postgraduate Certificate no fewer than 60 credits
 - ii. for the Postgraduate Diploma no fewer than 120 credits
 - iii. for the degree of MSc no fewer than 180 credits including all the compulsory modules and a dissertation or project.

9. **Award Degree of MSc:** In order to qualify for the award of the degree of the MSc in Economics and Finance, a candidate must have performed to the satisfaction of the Board of Examiners and must have accumulated no fewer than 180 credits, of which 40 must have been awarded in respect of the dissertation EC9XX Summer Project or Research Project 1 AG9XX and AG9XX Research Project 2.
10. **Postgraduate Diploma:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Economics and Finance, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 120 credits from the programme curriculum.
11. **Postgraduate Certificate:** In order to qualify for the award of the Postgraduate Certificate in Economics and Finance, a candidate must have accumulated no fewer than 60 credits from the programme curriculum.
