MEET THE STUDENTS & CAMPUS TOURS

Come along to our Meet the Students point on level 4 of the Learning and Teaching building (23) and find out from our current students what it's really like to study here.

A great way to see the campus is to go on a campus tour, led by our student ambassadors. Tours take approximately 40 minutes and leave from the Meet the Students point starting from 9.30am; the last tour departs at 1.45pm.

STUDENTS' UNION

The Students' Union (23) will be open from 9.30am, with lots going on.

ACCOMMODATION

Visit the Student Accommodation stand in the Learning and Teaching building, Level 3 (23). One of our student flats on campus will be open to visitors, and staff on the stand can give you directions. LIBRARY

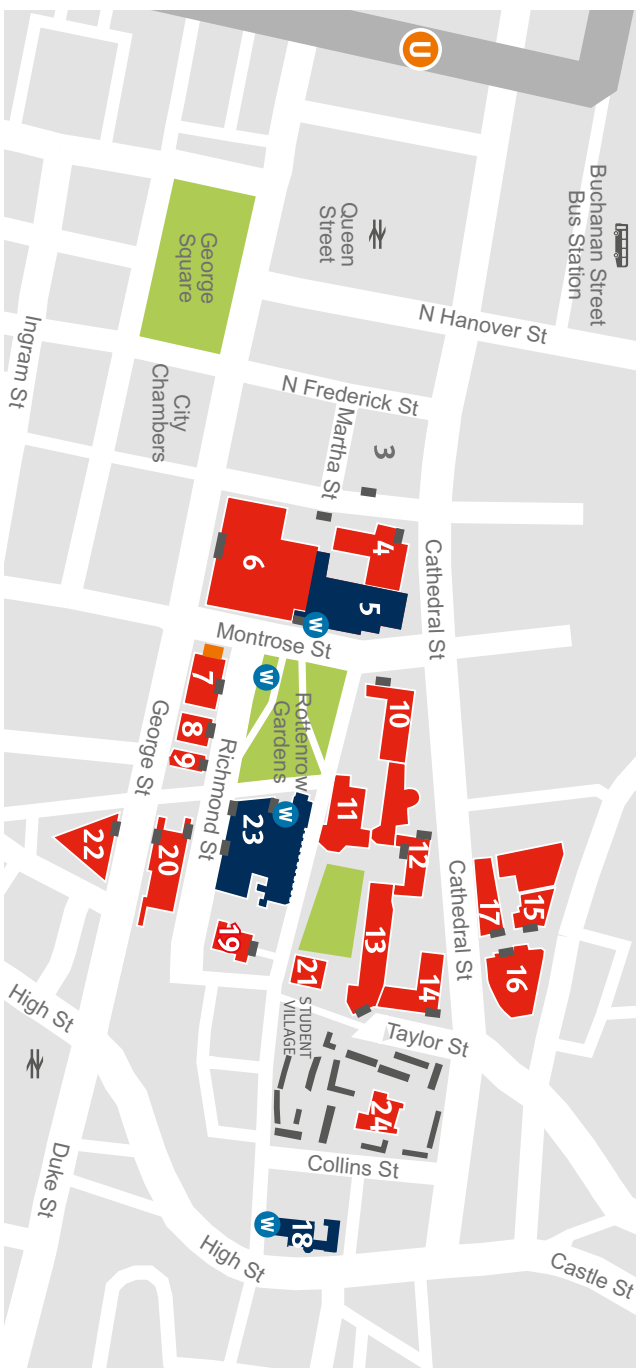
