Champagne & Sparkling Wine

Baron Albert Champagne £50.00

A wonderful fresh, clean style with hints of exotic fruit and floral note. This is champagne full of elegance and finesse.

Villa Sandi "Il Fresco" Prosecco Brute £28.95

A fine persistent perlage, and a fruity, flowery aroma with hints of ripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. The dry, fresh and flavoursome sensation on the palate is followed by a fruity aftertaste. Citrus and melon aromas fill the nose with hints of fruit trees and a touch of vanilla.

Villa Sandi Prosecco Rosato £28.95

A light and bright rose colour with a fine and delicate perlage. A fruity and flowery bouquet with delicate notes of unripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. A dry, fresh and zesty flavour with a fruity and harmonious aftertaste.

Prosecco La Delfina £22.50

An excellent Prosecco showing light, fresh and fruity flavours of pear and a little citrus. Enjoy well chilled.

White Wine

France

Baron P. Rothschild, Sauvignon Blanc £19.50

From the World famous wine making dynasty. A delicious fragrant wine with the powerful aroma of the Sauvignon grape – dry side of medium.

Chablis, Domaine du Guette du Soleil £39.25

A small Domaine making a super Chablis. Crisp mineral and green apple notes lead to weight on the palate, salted almonds and greengage, before the finish leaves the palate clean and refreshed.

Pouilly Fumé, Domaine de Berthiers £40.50

An excellent single vineyard wine. It has length with a fragrant bouquet.

Italy

La Delfina Pinot Grigio £15.50

Pinot Grigio is the racy, fashionable wine to drink now. Very approachable on its own or with food. This crisp, dry white has all the hallmarks of Pinot Grigio. Citrus fruits on the nose with a refreshing palate of zesty green apple and fresh pear.

New Zealand

Giesen Sauvignon Blanc £25.50

A pale yellow appearance with the green hues associated with New Zealand Sauvignon. This wine has aromas of green pineapple, apple, freshly crushed mint plus tropical undertones. The palate provides texture on the mid tongue then fruit sweetness and a balanced, clean, dry yet persistent flavour on the finish.

Hunters Sauvignon Blanc £31.50

A wine with intense fruit character, and a pleasing freshness, derived from its herbaceous overtones. Ernie & Jane Huter were the founders of vineyards in Marlborough in the late 1970s. This wine is still produced by the Hunter family.

Australia

Yalumba Y Series Unwooded Chardonnay £24.50

Pale straw green in colour, the Yalumba Y Series Unwooded Chardonnay offers enticing aromas of white peach, grapefruit and nougat – a complex interplay showing balance between ripe fruit and complexity from lees ageing. The palate is distinctly medium bodied with layers of white peach and nougat flavours, racy acidity and a persistent finish.

Chile

Loma Negra Sauvignon Blanc Reserva £18.50

This wine shows a deep green-tinged pale yellow, characterized by its freshness on the nose, with intense notes of lemon blossoms, which add complexity to the aromatic profile. A freshness on the palate is well-balanced with crisp acidity and a long persistent finish.

House Wine

Baron d'Arignac Vin du Pays du Gers £17.00

A clean, fresh wine from Southern France with a pleasant grapey, fruity flavour. Not too dry.

Red Wine

France

Ch. La Tours de Mons, Margaux, Cru Bourgeois £52.50

With an intense colour, the wine displays a very broad aromatic range.

Elegant and distinguished, this is an enticing wine with a black fruit scented nose (cherry, blackberry), meaty and delicious mouth-feel with elegant woody touches and a long cacao finish.

Rhône

Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Chemin de Papes £51.00

Deep coloured. Spicy, slightly earthy nose with a savoury complexity. The palate is earthy and spicy with raspberry and cherry fruit coupled with firm tannins.

Argentina

La Colonia Malbec £19.50

Malbec is now world renowned. With its sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper, it is perfect with Steak. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish make it drinkable on its own or with food.

Italy

Nicalo Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Tedeschi £32.50

A rich style of Valpolicella from a family who have almost 4 centuries in the wine making business. Nicalo is a strong Ruby red colour with currants and cherries on the palate. Up to 18 months in oak gives it a nose of vanilla and tobacco.

New Zealand

Giesen Pinot Noir £25.50

The soft light red wine produced from Pinot Noir has typical red cherry, clove, brambles and lavender on its nose. Followed by cherry, warm spice, silky tannin it has a finely structured palate. These three Giesen brothers have successfully brought their German heritage and style of winemaking to New Zealand.

Hunters Pinot Noir Marlborough £36.00

Aged in French Oak, softness is the key, strawberry and plums with a touch of spice and velvet finish. Rich ripe plum and berry aromas marry together for a smooth medium bodied Pinot Noir. The palate shows persistent rich cherry/plum flavours and mild spicy oak making an enjoyable and easy drinking wine.

Australia

Yalumba Y Series, Shiraz £24.50

South Australia. Tasty fresh fruit with a smooth even finish, in short – a real delight. Dense purple in colour, this wine has intense aromas of ripe blackberry, blood plum, chocolate and licorice. Rich and juicy, it is a big mouthful of Australia with soft juicy tannins and a moreish finish.

Chile

Loma Negra Carménère Reserva £18.50

This wine presents an intense ruby red colour with clean deep hues of violet. Those nose has aromas of spices and dried figs along with a soft touch of black pepper. The palate is complex with a fresh acidity and soft, round tannins.

House Wine

Baron d'Arignac Vin du Pays D'Oc £17.00

Specially selected from the sunny south, soft flavoursome red with good weight and colour.

Rosé Wine

Baron d'Arignac Rosé £17.00

A refreshing and delicate rosé, packed full of summer fruit flavours. Not just restricted to summer drinking.
