

Wine List

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

Baron Albert Traditional Brut Champagne £50.00

A wonderful fresh, clean style with hints of exotic fruit and floral note. This is champagne full of elegance and finesse.

Villa Sandi "Il Fresco" Prosecco Brute £33.00

A fine persistant perlage, and a fruity, flowery aroma with hints of ripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. The dry, fresh and flavoursome sensation on the palate is followed by a fruity aftertaste. Citrus and melon aromas fill the nose with hints of fruit trees and a touch of vanilla.

Villa Sandi Prosecco Millesimato Rose £33.00

A light and bright rose colour with a fine and delicate perlage. A fruity and flowery bouquet with delicate notes of unripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. A dry, fresh and zesty flavour with a fruity and harmonious aftertaste.

Prosecco La Delfina £25.00

An excellent Prosecco showing light, fresh and fruity flavours of pear and a little citrus. Enjoy well chilled.

White Wine

France

Marquis de Goulaine, Sauvignon Blanc £26.50

Flinty zesty Sauvignon from France's cool Loire Valley. It has the sophistication of a Sancerre, so it's like a 'baby' version of this classic and goes excellently with Salmon, Seafood and even a Fish Supper! The owner claims direct decent from Mary, Queen of Scots and the winery was established in 982, making it the 3rd oldest registered company in the world.

Chablis, Domaine du Guette du Soleil £42.50

A small Domaine making a super Chablis. Crisp mineral and green apple notes lead to weight on the palate, salted almonds and greengage, before the finish leaves the palate clean and refreshed.

Pouilly Fumé, Domaine de Berthiers £44.00

An excellent single vineyard wine. Refined and classy Sauvignon, with a lively palate, redolent with herbaceous notes. A signature flinty minerality and a dry elegant finish.

Italy

La Delfina Pinot Grigio £22.50

Pinot Grigio is the racy, fashionable wine to drink now. Very approachable on its own or with food. This crisp, dry white has all the hallmarks of Pinot Grigio. Citrus fruits on the nose with a refreshing palate of zesty green apple and fresh pear.

South Africa

Delheim Sauvignon Blanc £27.00

This light-toned wine has a green hue, expressing its youthfulness. On the nose aromas of tropical and citrus fruit, along with gooseberry, are supported by a lush palate of greenages and lime. Complements dishes such as baked aubergine and pumpkin, linefish and a variety of summer salads. Suitable for vegans.

New Zealand

Hunters Sauvignon Blanc £33.00

A wine with intense fruit character, and a pleasing freshness, derived from its herbaceous overtones. Ernie & Jane Hunter were the founders of vineyards in Marlborough in the late 70s. This wine is still produced by the Hunter family.

Australia

Yalumba Y Series Unwooded Chardonnay £26.00

Pale straw green in colour, the Yalumba Y Series Unwooded Chardonnay offers enticing aromas of white peach, grapefruit and nougat – a complex interplay showing balance between ripe fruit and complexity from lees ageing. The palate is distinctly medium bodied with layers of white peach and nougat flavours, racy acidity and a persistent finish.

Chile

Loma Negra Sauvignon Blanc Reserva £24.50

This reserva wine shows a deep pale yellow tinge. It is characterized by its freshness on the nose, with intense notes of lemon blossoms, which add complexity to the aromatic profile. A freshness on the palate is well-balanced with crisp acidity and a long persistent finish.

House Wine

Baron d'Arignac Vin du Pays du Gers £21.00

A clean, fresh wine from Southern France with a pleasant grapey, fruity flavour. Not too dry.



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Red Wine

France

Château Grand Tuillac Cuvée Elégance, Bordeaux £37.50

Round, fruity (black and red berries) with elegant spicy notes. A wine that lasts in the mouth. Fruit aromas are coming back after every sip. The 30 days under marc (the solids of the grapes) give the wine all its tannic structure and reveal the qualities of the vintage. Very pleasant! Sophie & Laurent Poitevin inherited the winery after they got married nd have made it a labour of love.

Rhône

Côtes du Rhône, Bio Rouge, Rocca Maura £28.50

This wine comes from a single vineyard in Lirac, just across the river from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, where the farming is fully organic. The blend is dominated by Grenache giving a soft wine with floral notes on top of the red berry flavours. Perfect to accompany some lamb or game. Vegan friendly.

Argentina

Lorca, Lorca Malbec £24.00

Malbec is now world renowned. Dark, fresh and fruity from the famous Mendoza Uco Valley. Enjoy the aromas of ripe blackberries with floral, spicy notes, savour the soft tannins and juicy plum and cherry flavours, finishing with a touch of pepper.

Great with steaks, burgers or roast beef.

Italy

Barolo, Casali del Barone £47.50

A beautiful intense garnet colour, with a rich bouquet of plums, red fruits and jam. The palate is complex with aromas of eucalyptus, tobacco and leather. The wine has had long aging in both cask and bottle to develop beautiful complexities typical of good Barolo.

Nicalo Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Tedeschi £34.00

A rich style of Valpolicella from a family who have almost 4 centuries in the wine making business. Nicalo is a strong Ruby red colour with currants and cherries on the palate. Up to 18 months in oak gives it a nose of vanilla and tobacco.

New Zealand

Hunters Pinot Noir Marlborough £38.00

Aged in French Oak, softness is the key, strawberry and plums with a touch of spice and velvet finish. Rich ripe plum and berry aromas marry together for a smooth medium bodied Pinot Noir. The palate shows persistent rich cherry/plum flavours and mild spicy oak making an enjoyable and easy drinking wine.

Australia

Yalumba Y Series, Shiraz £26.00

South Australia. Tasty fresh fruit with a smooth even finish, in short – a real delight. Dense purple in colour, this wine has intense aromas of ripe blackberry, blood plum, chocolate and licorice. Rich and juicy, it is a big mouthful of Australia with soft juicy tannins and a moreish finish.

Chile

Loma Negra Carménère Reserva £24.00

This reserva presents an intense ruby red colour with clean deep hues of violet. The nose has aromas of spices and dried figs along with a soft touch of black pepper. The palate is complex with a fresh acidity and soft, round tannins.

House Wine

Baron d'Arignac Vin du Pays D'Oc £21.00

Specially selected from the sunny south, soft flavoursome red with good weight and colour.

Rosé Wine

Baron d'Arignac Rosé £21.00

A refreshing and delicate rosé, packed full of summer fruit flavours.
