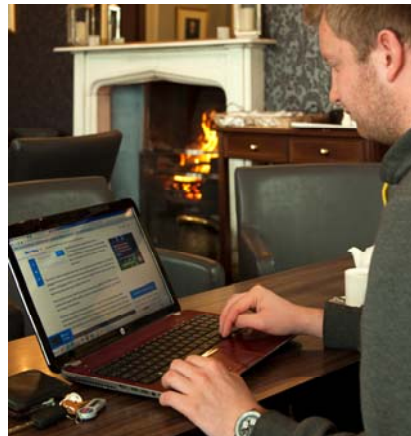

All Ross Priory Club members are very welcome to use the Bar/Lounge facilities for as long as you like to read a book or a newspaper, play a game of scrabble or even to work on your laptop or tablet on any day of the week, subject to opening hours. Like a café or coffee shop.

Members are not obliged to make any purchases, however hot and cold refreshments are available throughout the day, 7 days a week, with bar meals available over lunchtime and soup/sandwiches/scones/cakes into the afternoon and evening without prior booking.

Members should not consume food/drink within the house that has been purchased elsewhere.

Newspapers and board games are provided for members' use within the Bar/Lounge with compliments of the management or you are welcome to bring your own.

Opening hours



Our doors are open for all club members 7 days per week 9am to 11pm over the Spring/Summer months.

Over the winter (late October until early March) the hours of business are reduced to 9am-5pm unless a prior booking exists.

The only time the house closes is over the Christmas & New Year period.



Ross Priory has Wi-Fi throughout the house, in the Bar/Lounge and other reception rooms as well as in ALL THE BEDROOMS within the house. The signal has recently received a boost, with an upgrade to the local exchange and now runs at double the previous speed.

For any club member who does not drive, whether through choice or necessity, Ross Priory can offer a shuttle service to collect you from Balloch Station if you make a prior arrangement – please just call in advance to Ross Priory directly on 01389 830 398. This service is aimed at those who may otherwise be unable to take advantage of their club membership due to lack of mobility.



Bar lunches are available daily, Monday to Saturday 12.00pm-2.30pm and Sunday 12.00pm-3.00pm



Our bar lunch menu provides a wide range of options from soup & sandwiches and light bites to delicious mains and desserts, all set in lovely surroundings with fabulous views over the loch. The menu is changed seasonally. Daily specials are also offered. All Ross Priory Club members receive 15% discount.

In addition, outside these hours, we offer a breakfast butty selection, a particular favourite with golfers and walkers. Soup & sandwiches are always available in the afternoons and evenings (during opening hours) and selection of scones and cakes can be purchased alongside our selection of hot and cold beverages throughout the day.

All our bedrooms in the house have fantastic en suite facilities, but what was less publicised is that we have also had a completely new boiler system installed.

This has seen a vast improvement in the water pressure and temperature and has seen a significant improvement in the quality of the showering facilities for our residents.

The bedrooms in the house are available to book 7 days a week, 50 weeks of the year (only closed over the 2 weeks at Christmas/New Year) and open on all other bank holidays, subject to availability. Members are not restricted to special offer dates/deals.

Members and members' guests receive discounted rates at all times as well as the special deals that are promoted for selected dates.

The Golf Buggy at Ross Priory is used by staff for spot checking valid memberships and bag tags on the golf course and is also available to hire for a fee, if one of our club members feels the walk is too much.

It can be booked and is available on a first come, first served basis.

There are also 2 sets of golf clubs to hire and a trolley. Please enquire at the bar/office.



All members can use any free area of the meadow for family picnics and informal outdoors activities, like a game of rounders or football, any day of the week without booking. In the event of a booked event taking place, we would ask that any large parties contain activities to a particular section of the meadow.

Putters, swingball, croquet and boules sets are available for use for all the family. Please enquire at the bar.



We have a total of 8 picnic benches on the meadow area. For members' convenience we offer our 3ft gas barbecue to hire for a fee and you can cook your own food. Please provide your own utensils, crockery, cutlery etc.



All members have full access to the grounds and gardens for walking dogs, with the exception of specific areas such as the play park and walled garden, where 'no access' is clearly marked.

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the house.

For anyone looking for pet-friendly accommodation, our Lochside Cottage is available.

Dogs must have their own bedding and are not allowed on the furniture, but are otherwise very welcome to accompany you.
