## Faculty of Engineering Excellence Scholarship (FEES) for International Students - 2017/2018 Entry

The Faculty of Engineering at the University of Strathclyde is offering a substantial number of scholarships for self-funded, international (non-EU) fee paying students with excellent academic qualifications who have applied for a relevant course of study and are commencing their studies from September 2017 or later on in the 2017-2018 academic year. Students may be eligible for a Faculty of Engineering Excellence Scholarship (FEES) towards their tuition fees of up to £3,600\* for the first year of their course of study.

### Key details of scholarships

#### Undergraduate

- **£3,600 scholarships towards course tuition fees are available** for the first year of an undergraduate programme. Students must achieve an average of 75% + (or equivalent) in their high school grades to be considered.

#### Postgraduate Taught

- **£2,700 scholarships towards course tuition fees are available** for an MSc programme. Students must achieve a minimum of a 2:1 (or equivalent) in their undergraduate degree to be considered.

#### Postgraduate Research

- A number of scholarships of up to £3,600 towards course tuition fees for the first year of a full-time PHD are available. **Please note, applications are still being accepted for students commencing their PhD in academic session 2016-2017\*\*.**

#### Who is eligible?

All self-funded, international (non-EU) fee paying students holding an offer and wishing to commence their full-time undergraduate, postgraduate taught or postgraduate research programme at Strathclyde in academic year 2017-2018 are eligible to apply.

#### How to apply

You should write no more than 500 words on why you should receive a Faculty of Engineering Excellence Scholarship. #### Important notes

- The application process is now open. Completed application forms should be submitted as early as possible.
- Please note that you can only apply for a scholarship once you have applied for a place on a full-time course through the University of Strathclyde's admission process and have been offered either a conditional or unconditional place.
- The Faculty of Engineering Excellence Scholarship is only eligible for self-funded, international (non-EU) fee paying students enrolling on a full-time course. Please note that students who receive sponsorship from a government office, embassy, educational establishment or an employer are not eligible to apply for this scholarship
- Students are only eligible for one scholarship per academic year. Students may apply for scholarships in subsequent years of study, if appropriate
- The Faculty of Engineering Excellence Scholarship scheme is open until 11<sup>th</sup> August 2017\*\*\*, however students are advised to submit their application as early as possible due to expected demand for these scholarships
- Students who do not meet any of the required criteria in this announcement will automatically not be considered

\* based on tuition fee of £18,000. The amount may vary for some courses, including Architecture and Biomedical Engineering

\*\*PhD students commencing in 2016-17 should use the 2017-18 application form
