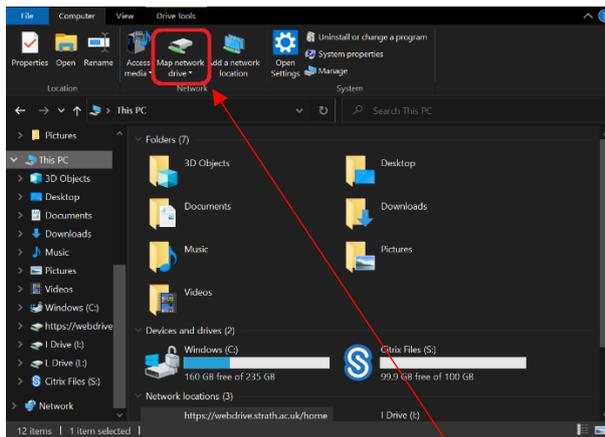
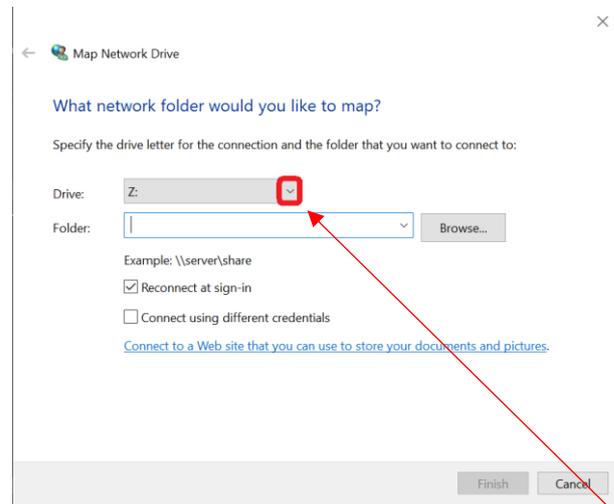


Map a Drive

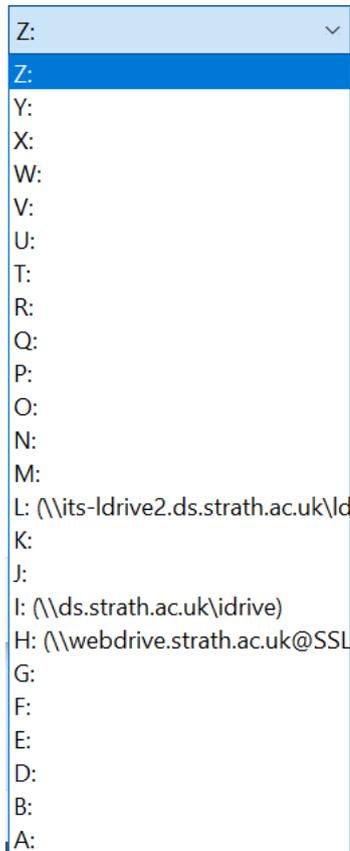
You can map your H: Drive or I: Drive on your Windows computer while on campus or connected through VPN.



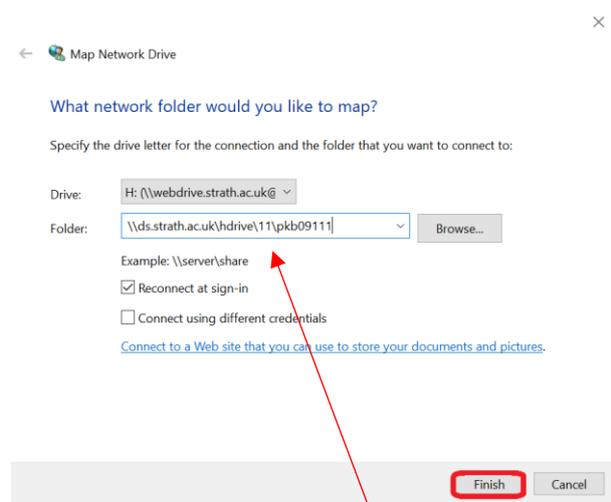
1. In This PC folder, click on Map network drive.



2. In the window that appears, where it says Drive:, click on the drop-down button.



3. From the drop down menu, select H: or I:.



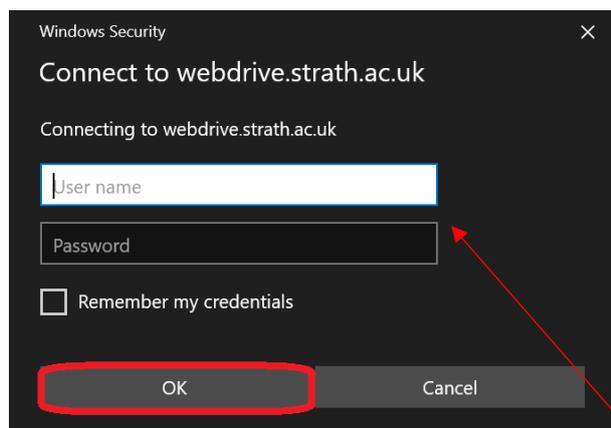
4. Where it says Folder:, enter \\ds.strath.ac.uk\, then the name of the drive.

For example, [\\ds.strath.ac.uk\idrive](https://ds.strath.ac.uk/idrive) for your I: Drive.

If it is your H: Drive, after \hdrive, enter the last 2 digits of your username, then your username.

For example, [\\ds.strath.ac.uk\hdrive\11\pkb09111](https://ds.strath.ac.uk/hdrive/11/pkb09111) for H: Drive.

Click on Finish.



5. In the pop-up box that appears, enter your username and password, then click on OK.
