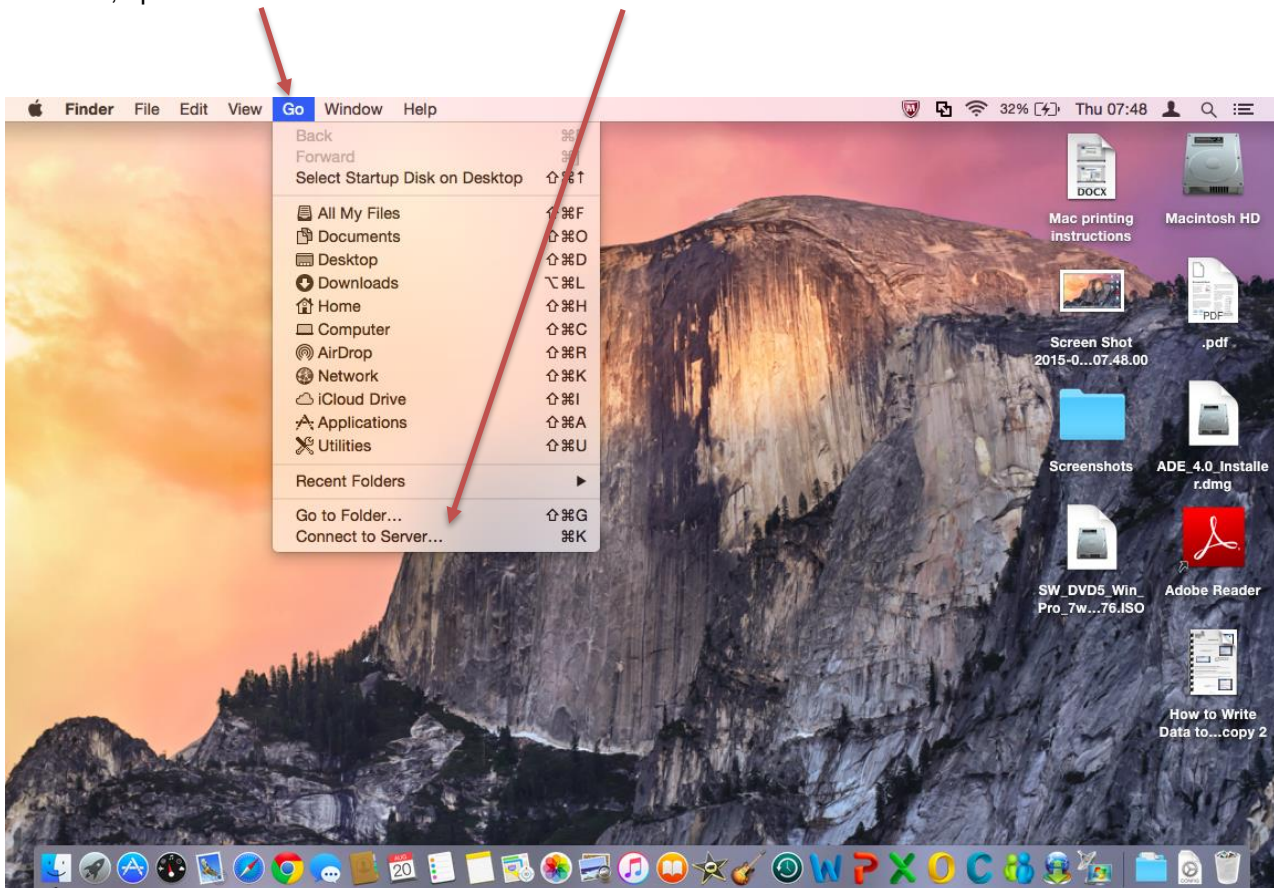


## Accessing your Network Drives (H: and i: drive) on MAC OSX 10.4 onwards

### Instructions for on-campus, or using VPN off-campus

If you are off-campus, then begin by connecting to the [Forticlient VPN](#). Once you're connected, follow the on-campus instructions below :

In Finder, open the **Go** menu and select **Connect to Server**



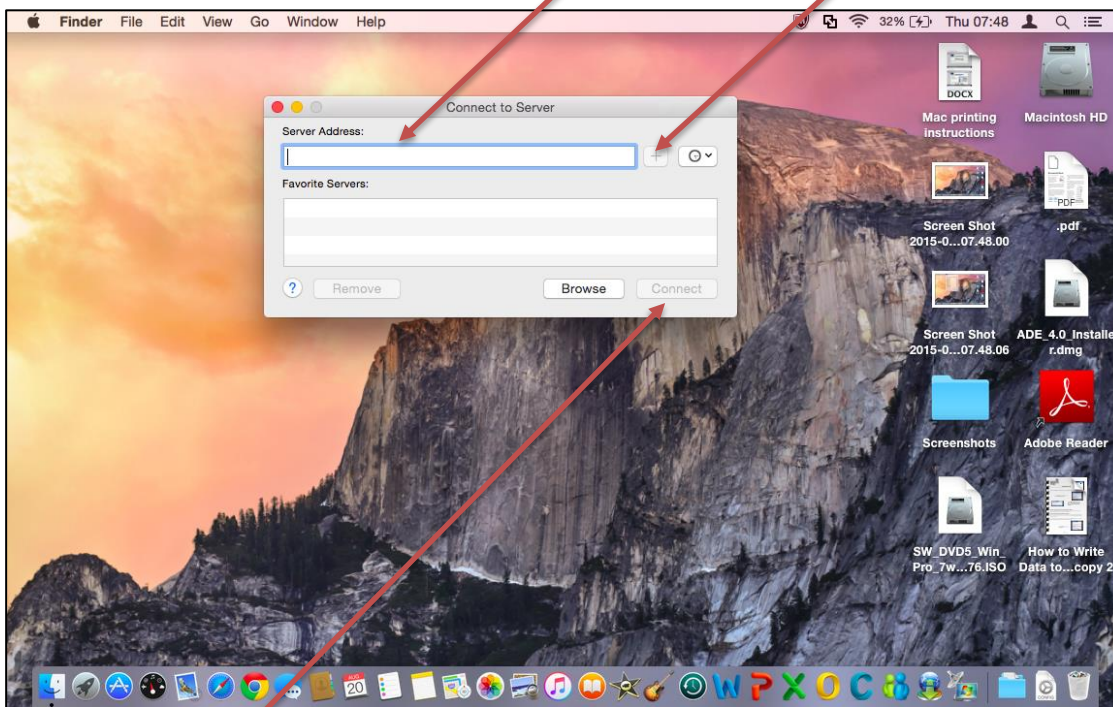
In the **Server address** field enter the address for the drive you want to connect to and click on the + symbol.

**For your H: Drive**, enter the address in the form below;

**smb://ds.strath.ac.uk/hdrive/** last two digits of your username / username.

Example;

**smb://ds.strath.ac.uk/hdrive/17/efa18617**

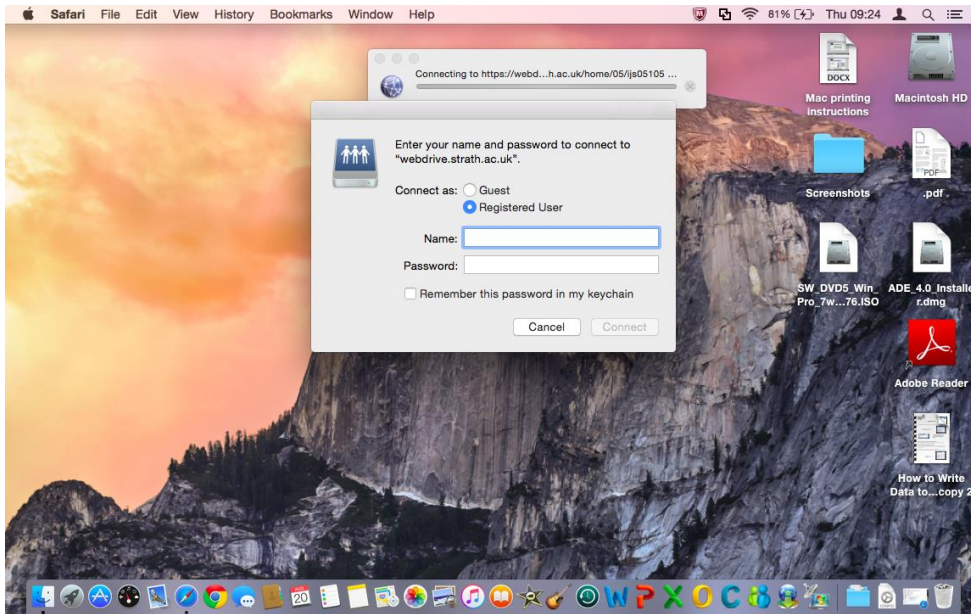


Select **Connect**.

**Or, for your i: Drive**, enter the below address;

**smb://ds.strath.ac.uk/idrive**

When prompted to logon, enter "**ds\**" followed by your username & then your password. Select **Connect**.



Your folders should display in the window that opens.

### Connecting in future :

Your Network drive will display within **Connect to Server** as a **Favourite Server** each time you log on to your computer.

Select the Network drive you wish to connect to. When prompted to logon, enter "**ds\**" followed by your username & then your password. Select **Connect**.
