


Set up VPN on Android

You can download FortiClient VPN from the Google Play Store. The following instructions show the steps setting up VPN on Android devices. Different versions of Android may vary slightly in layout but the process will remain the same.





- 1. Find FortiClient VPN in the Google Play Store, then select Install.
- 2. Once the installation is complete, select Open.



Privacy Policy Highlights

FortiClient DOES NOT collect and send any user specific personal information like username, photos or email address to Fortinet



FortiClient may collect anonymous usage information and share with Fortinet for the purpose of improving usability and functionality



FortiClient does not monitor end user VPN traffic



FortiClient Webfilter feature, if enabled, submits website urls to Fortinet servers for category rating.



5. Select OK.




6. Select Allow.

7. Click on Enable.




8. Where it says Add VPN, enter University of Strathclyde.

Select Create.







11. Where it says Remote Gateways, tap to enter.


12. Where it says Server, enter vpn.strath.ac.uk, then select OK.










