

Fee Status Documentation – What you might send in as evidence

Immigration Status	Possible Evidence
Right of Abode	Copy of relevant page(s) of passport - Certificate of Entitlement to Right of Abode (including page(s) confirming name and nationality)
Indefinite Leave to Enter or Indefinite Leave to Remain	Copy of relevant page(s) of passport (including page(s) confirming name and nationality) and/or Home Office letter
Refugee Status OR the Child or Spouse/Civil Partner of someone granted Refugee Status	Home Office letter (and any relevant enclosure) or (if granted Refugee Status) refugee travel document
Refused Refugee status but granted one of the following <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exceptional Leave to Enter/Remain • Humanitarian Protection • Discretionary Leave OR the Child or Spouse/Civil Partner of someone refused Refugee Status but granted one of the above	If appropriate – proof of relationship at time asylum application was made eg marriage certificate, birth certificate Proof of asylum application If asylum has been refused, letter confirming refusal of application
Time Limit on Stay <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Date last passport stamp/ visa was issued • Date of expiry of most recent permission to stay 	Copy of relevant page(s) of passport (including page(s) confirming name and nationality). Any pages or other documents indicating type of immigration permission.
If none of the above categories apply, or status is likely to change before the start of the course, eg course starts in September, status changes by 1 st August, please send any details and supporting evidence of status within the UK	
If you are a UK National currently resident overseas, please send in evidence of reason for absence from UK
