**VACATION ARRANGEMENTS 2022/23**

Student visa holders can work unlimited full-time hours during the vacation periods noted below, depending on the level of their course of study. Students can prove their right to work by supplying this letter as well as the following:

- Student status letter
- Confirmation of award or their final results letter - this will show that they have completed their studies
- Their share code proving their right to work

**WORKING PERMISIONS – SPRING VACATION 2023**

Undergraduate students – full-time 03 April 2023 – 16 April 2023 (inclusive)

Postgraduate students – full-time 03 April 2023 – 16 April 2023 (inclusive)

PhD Students are restricted to 20 hours per week during this vacation period.

**WORKING PERMISIONS – SUMMER VACATION 2023**

Undergraduate students – full-time 22 May 2023 – 10 September 2023 (inclusive)

Postgraduate and PhD students are restricted to 20 hours per week during this vacation period.

**WORKING FULL-TIME ON COMPLETION OF STUDIES**

Students with a Tier 4 or Student visa type can also work full-time until the end of their visa if their status letter confirms their registration status as COMPLETED.
