

Applying to the Accelerate Programme: A Guide for Parents/Guardians

All of the places on the Accelerate Programme are fully funded and offered to pupils based on our Widening Access criteria. These criteria are:

- Attendance at one of the University's target schools. For a list of target schools, please see <u>Strathclyde Target Schools List</u>
- If your home postcode is in Quintile 1 or 2 based on the Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation. You can check your postcode here: <u>SIMD Postcode Look Up</u>
- Young Carer
- Care-Experienced
- Free School Meals
- Asylum Seeker/Refugee

If a pupil matches at least one of these criteria, they will have a very good chance of being offered a place on the programme. Unfortunately, if they do not match any of these criteria, we will not be able to offer them a place on the programme.

Applying to the Programme

If your son/daughter match at least one of our widening access criteria, you can apply on their behalf to the programme. This is a <u>three-step process</u>.

Step 1: Application for Funded Place

First, we need to confirm that your son/daughter matches at least one of our widening access criteria. Please complete the <u>Accelerate 2025 Individual Funding Request Form</u> which asks for details relating to our criteria. Please ensure that you include the full name of the pupil's school and the pupil's home postcode.

Pupils should complete the personal statement. It's important that pupils are interested in potentially going on to study their Accelerate challenge subject at University and pupils should demonstrate this in their personal statement. If pupils are interested in studying a different subject at University, they will not be offered a place on that Accelerate Challenge.

The deadline for receiving forms is 21st March, 2025. We will assess all applications after this deadline and will award places based on our criteria.

Step 2: Registration on the Programme

If your son/daughter is successful in receiving a funded place, we will email you to confirm this shortly after 21st March. In this email, we will send you a link to the formal registration



form for the programme. Again, the Parent/Guardian should complete this form. We will provide you with a reference number. Please use this when completing the form. **Please register before 25**th **April 2025.**

Step 3: Confirmation of Registration

Once you have completed the form at the link provided, an email confirming the pupil's place on the programme and providing more information will be sent to the parent/guardian and the pupil.

Please note – until this online registration form has been completed and you have received a confirmation email, you do not have a place on the programme.

*There are two methods of applying for a funded place on the Accelerate programme; either individually, using the process above, or through your child's school. **Please only apply individually if your school is not submitting an application for your child.***

The diagram below hopefully makes the three-step application process for Accelerate clear:

Step 1

Complete the *Accelerate 2025 Individual Funding Request*Form by 21.03.25.

Step 2

If your son/daughter is successful in getting a funded place, we send you a link to the programme registration form.

Parent/Guardian should complete this form before

25.04.25.

Step 3

A confirmation email is sent to the pupil and parent/guardian providing information about Accelerate. The process is now complete and you have a place on the programme.
