## Becoming a First or Second Supervisor

The programme has been developed to allow participants to choose the combination of workshops that best suits their developmental needs. If you are using the programme to become a first or second supervisor, you will need to complete a total of **5 workshops from the Supervisor Development Programme plus a reflective presentation**, all within 18 months to complete your Supervisor Training.

## Registering as a First Supervisor

If you wish to be added to the list of staff eligible to act as First Supervisors (often described as being 'on the list') you will need to:

- Register on the Strathclyde Supervisor Development Programme by enrolling on this Myplace site <https://classes.myplace.strath.ac.uk/course/view.php?id=22977>
- Indicate on the Myplace site that you wish to be added to the list of staff eligible to act as First Supervisors
- Attend the Core Workshop 'Becoming a Strathclyde Supervisor'

You will be added to the list of staff eligible to act as First Supervisors on completion of the core Workshop 'Becoming a Strathclyde Supervisor'. To remain on the list, you must complete your Supervisor Training within 18 months.
