

## SPSS 24.0 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This document contains graphical representations of the screens that will appear when downloading & installing SPSS 24 (based on Internet Explorer /Windows 10, other versions of browser/operating system may vary). Software downloads can be accessed from the [software catalogue](#) or [Pegasus](#). This guide provides instructions for installing the software package from Pegasus.

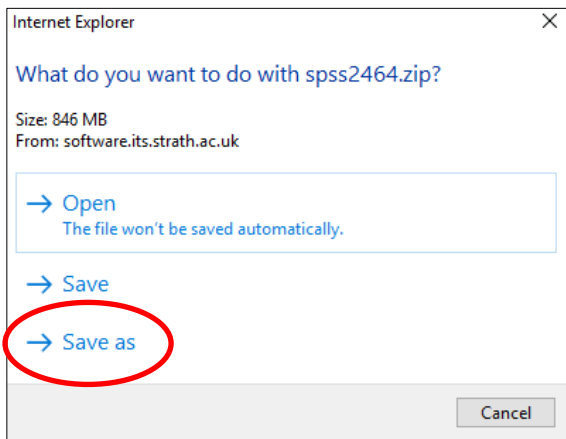

**To download the Software:**

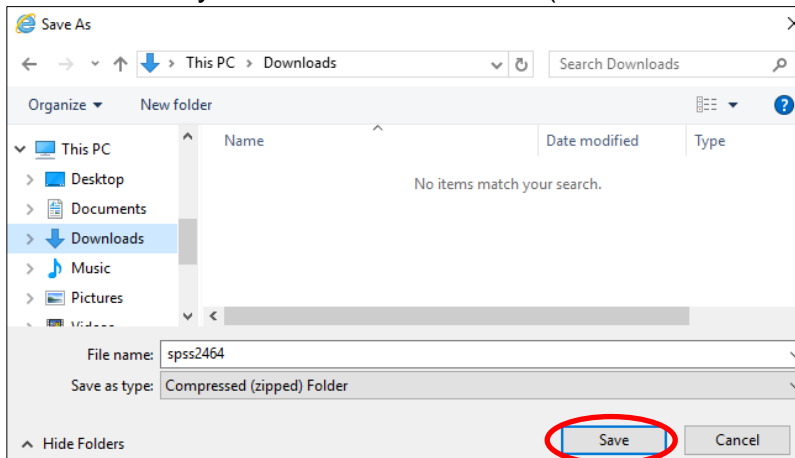
1. Click the link below to commence download.

## Click **Save As**



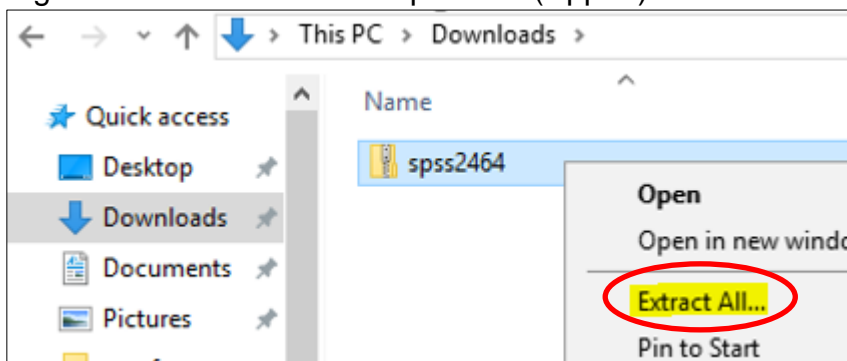
Select where you wish to save the file (**Downloads** is normally the default), Click **Save**



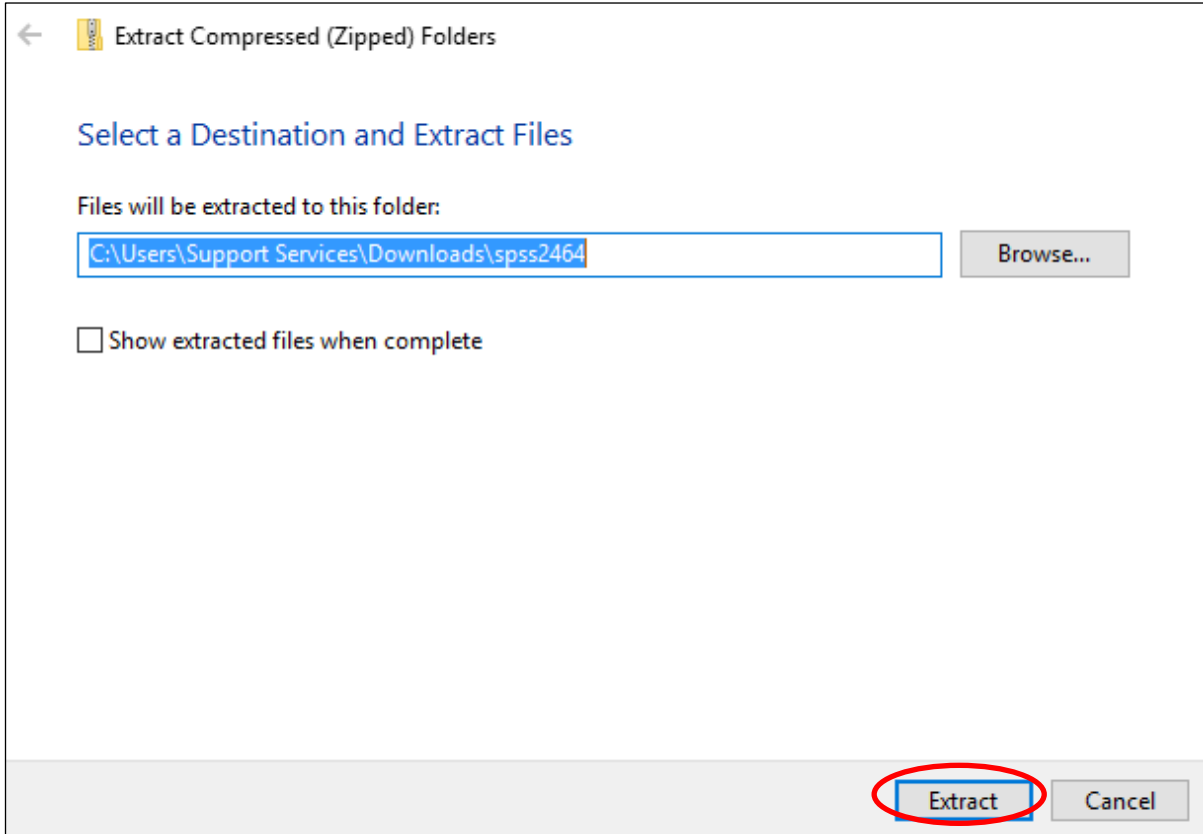
When the download is complete, select **Open Folder**



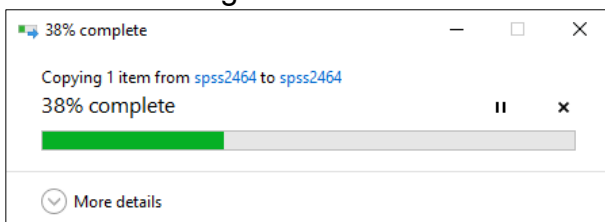
Right click on the SPSS compressed (zipped) folder and select **Extract All**



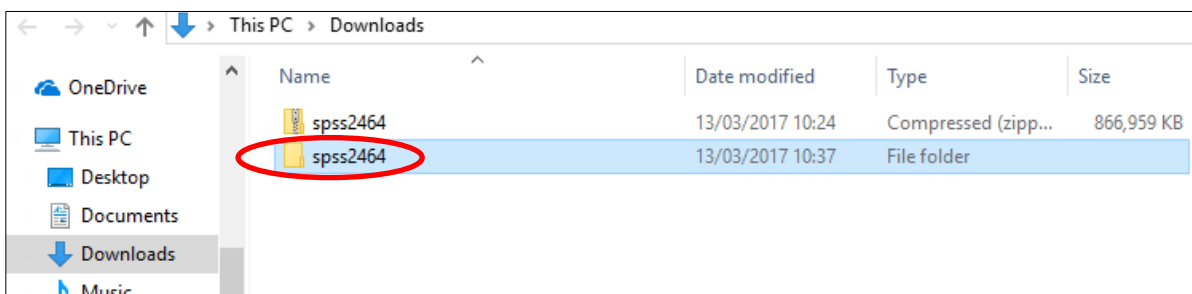
In the window that follows, choose **Extract**



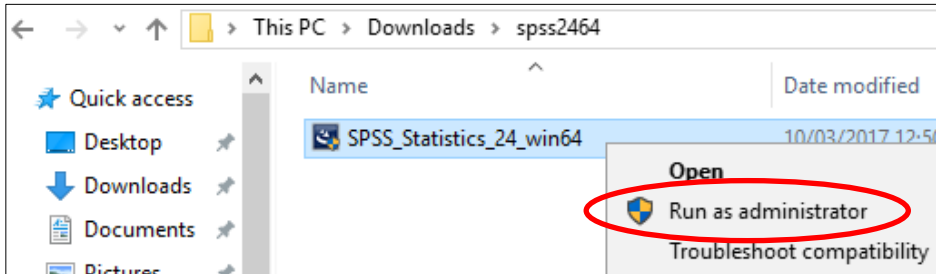
The files will begin to extract...



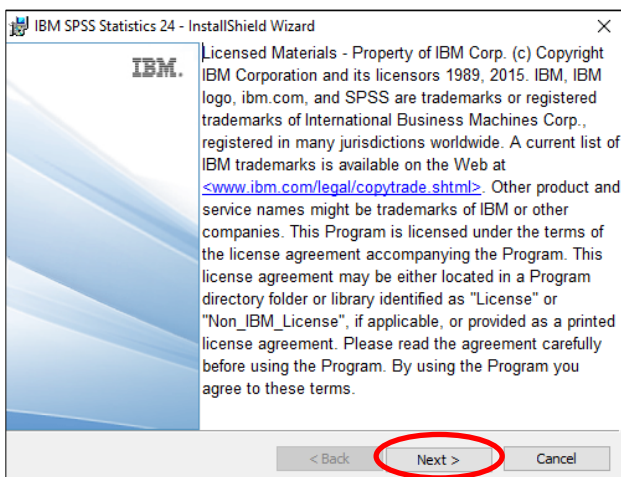
When extraction is complete there will be 2 folders available, open the extracted folder



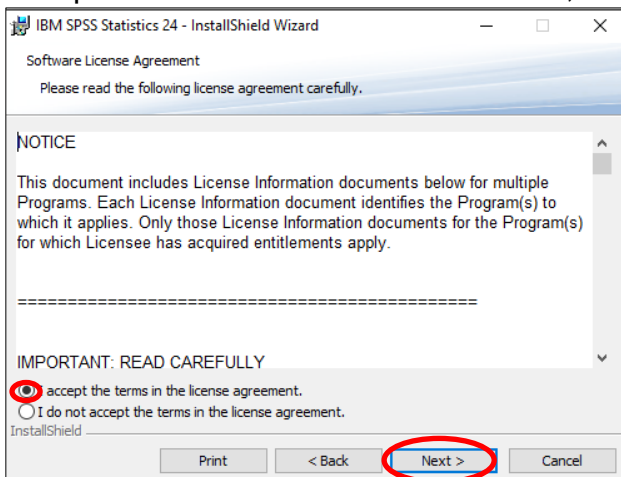
Right click on the setup file and select **Run as Administrator**



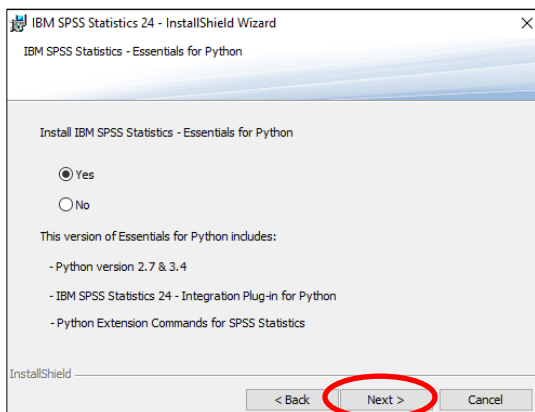
Select **Next**



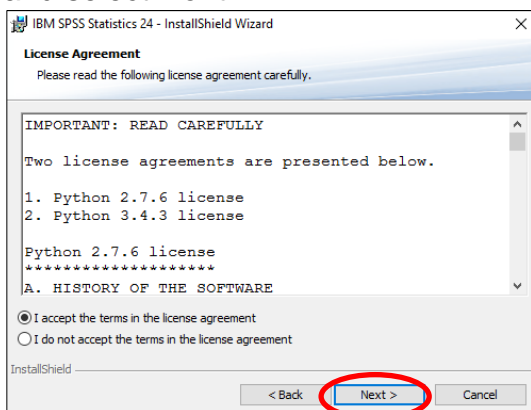
Accept the license terms and conditions, Select **Next**



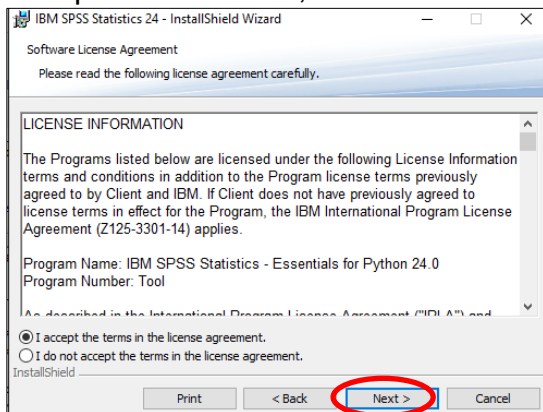
Choose whether to install Python or not, if unsure just go with default option of Yes, Select **Next**



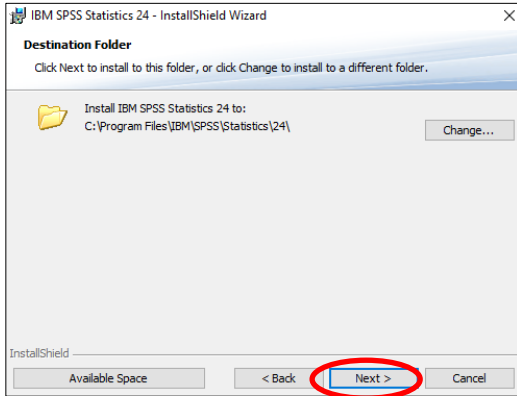
If installing Python, you will be prompted to accept the license terms and conditions, Accept and select **Next**:



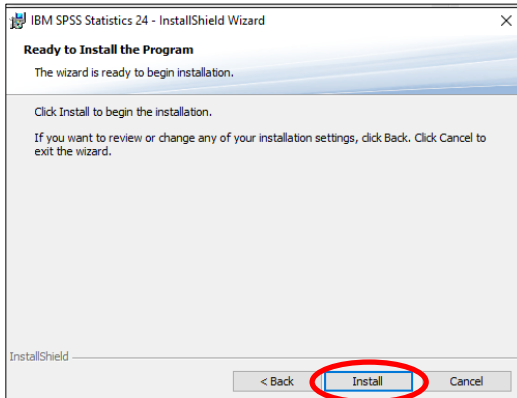

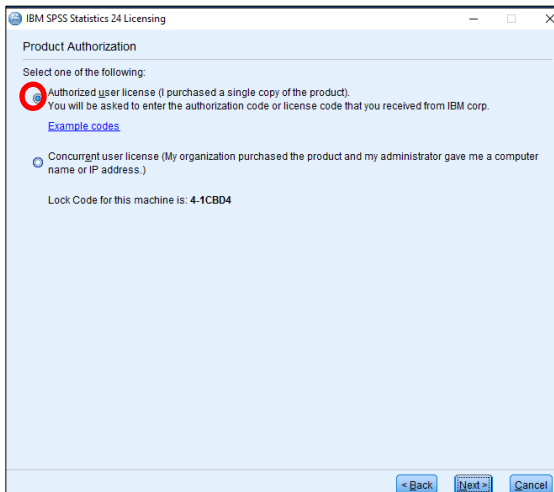

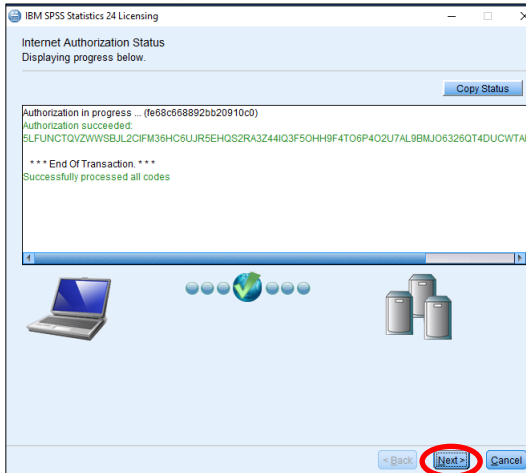
